From the funds appropriated to the Oklahoma Historical Society in Enrolled House Bill No. 2900 of the 1st 14 15 Session of the 58th Oklahoma Legislature, not less than One Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$150,000.00) shall be used to hire a grant 16 writer for Black Towns in Oklahoma. 17 SECTION 2. From the funds appropriated to the Oklahoma 18 Historical Society in Enrolled House Bill No. 2900 of the 1st 19 Session of the 58th Oklahoma Legislature, not less than One Hundred 20 Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$150,000.00) shall be used to provide grants 21 for schools to provide transportation to the Freedom Center & Clara 22

Luper Civil Rights Center, the Greenwood Historic District, and the

Oklahoma City National Memorial and Museum.

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1 SECTION 3. Appropriations made to the Oklahoma Historical 2 Society by Enrolled House Bill No. 2900 of the 1st Session of the 3 58th Oklahoma Legislature, not including appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for the fiscal year ending 4 5 June 30, 2022 (hereafter FY-22), or may be budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2023 (hereafter FY-23). Funds budgeted for FY-6 7 22 may be encumbered only through June 30, 2022, and must be expended by November 15, 2022. Any funds remaining after November 9 15, 2022, and not budgeted for FY-23, shall lapse to the credit of 10 the proper fund for the then current fiscal year. Funds budgeted for FY-23 may be encumbered only through June 30, 2023. Any funds 11 remaining after November 15, 2023, shall lapse to the credit of the 12 13 proper fund for the then current fiscal year. These appropriations shall not be budgeted in both fiscal years simultaneously. Funds 14 budgeted in FY-22, and not required to pay obligations for that 15 fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-23, after the agency to which 16 17 the funds have been appropriated has prepared and submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds from the FY-22 budget 18 work program and after such revision has been approved by the Office 19 of Management and Enterprise Services. 20
