15	is hereby authorized to establish within <del>said</del> <u>the</u> Department or
16	within any of the institutions operated by the Department training
17	programs to train necessary personnel for the Department or its
18	institutions, or may arrange for programs with any public <u>or private</u>
19	school, entity or institution within this state having available
20	facilities for training. Training may occur individually pursuant
21	to the Quality Workforce for Oklahoma's Heroes Act. Funds of the
22	Department or its institutions may be used to pay salaries or
23	tuition and subsistence for employees or prospective employees in

1 said the training programs, pursuant to the provisions of subsection
2 B of this section.

Any employee or prospective employee who, while receiving 3 в. such training is paid a salary, or for whom tuition and subsistence 4 5 are furnished shall enter into a contract with the Department prior to receiving any payment for salary, tuition, or subsistence. 6 The contract shall be in accordance with the rules and regulations 7 promulgated by the Oklahoma Veterans Commission and shall include a 8 9 stipulation that, unless the employee or prospective employee 10 continues in the employ of the Department for a period equivalent of 11 time that is greater than or equal to the length of the training, 12 the employee or prospective employee shall reimburse the Department 13 or institution for the amount of money paid to or for him or her by the Department during the training period. 14

15 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation 16 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby 17 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and 18 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
