7 An Act relating to career and technology education;  
8 allowing the State Board of Career and Technology  
9 Education to establish certain courses in hydrogen  
10 energy; allowing the Board to consult the Oklahoma  
11 Department of Commerce and the Department of Labor in  
12 establishing courses; providing for codification;  
13 providing an effective date; and declaring an  
14 emergency.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
17 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 14-136 of Title 70, unless there  
18 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

19 A. The State Board of Career and Technology Education may  
20 establish courses in the area of hydrogen energy. The courses may  
21 include but are not limited to the following topics:

22 1. Hydrogen energy basics;

23 2. Hydrogen energy-related equipment manufacturing and  
24 maintenance;

3. Hydrogen energy infrastructure; and

4. Hydrogen energy safety.

1 B. The State Board of Career and Technology Education may  
2 consult the Oklahoma Department of Commerce and the Department of  
3 Labor in establishing courses that meet the workforce needs of the  
4 hydrogen energy sector in this state.

5 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2022.

6 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
7 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby  
8 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
9 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
