6 An Act relating to child support; amending 43 O.S.
7 2011, Section 119.1, which relates to legislative
8 review of child support guidelines; requiring review
9 of certain schedule; establishing requirements for
10 certain review; requiring Department of Human
11 Services to promulgate rules for certain purposes;
12 requiring publication of certain information on
13 official websites; and providing an effective date.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 43 O.S. 2011, Section 119.1, is
16 amended to read as follows:

17 Section 119.1. A. The child support guidelines and schedule of
18 basic child support obligations shall be reviewed at least once
19 every four (4) years by the Judiciary Committees of the Senate and
20 the House of Representatives to ensure that their application
21 results in the determination of appropriate child support award
22 amounts.

23 B. In conducting the review required pursuant to subsection A
24 of this section, the Judiciary Committees shall:

25 1. Obtain from the Title IV-D Child Support Program in the
26 Department of Human Services economic data on the cost of raising a

1 child, labor market data, case data and case analysis. The
2 Department shall promulgate rules as needed to implement the
3 provisions of this paragraph;

4 2. Provide opportunity for public input from persons including,
5 but not limited to, low-income custodial and noncustodial parents
6 and their representatives; and

7 3. Publish on the official websites of the Senate and the House
8 of Representatives information related to the review including, but
9 not limited to, the membership of the committees conducting the
10 review, the effective date of the guidelines and the date of the
11 next review.

12 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2021.
