For elections to be held after July 1, 2022, any state 15 agency, board, or commission that owns or leases a facility located 16 in or near a precinct without a suitable polling place available, 17 shall make space within the facility available for use as a polling 18 place upon the written request of the secretary of the county 19 election board. 20 B. For elections to be held after July 1, 2022, any political 21 subdivision of this state that held an election that was conducted 22 by a county election board on or after January 1, 2018, and that 23 owns, rents, or leases a facility located in or near a precinct 24

without a suitable polling place available, shall make space within
 the facility available for use as a polling place upon the written
 request of the secretary of the county election board.

C. For facilities described in subsection A or B of this
section, a reasonable maintenance or cleaning fee may be charged to
the county election board for use of the facility as a polling
place.

8 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2022.

9 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
10 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
11 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
12 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
