6 An Act relating to polling places; providing for
7 additional polling places for certain precincts;
8 authorizing maintenance and cleaning fee for certain
9 facilities; providing for codification; providing an
10 effective date; and declaring an emergency.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
13 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3-120.1 of Title 26, unless
14 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

15 A. For elections to be held after July 1, 2022, any state
16 agency, board, or commission that owns or leases a facility located
17 in or near a precinct without a suitable polling place available,
18 shall make space within the facility available for use as a polling
19 place upon the written request of the secretary of the county
20 election board.

21 B. For elections to be held after July 1, 2022, any political
22 subdivision of this state that held an election that was conducted
23 by a county election board on or after January 1, 2018, and that
24 owns, rents, or leases a facility located in or near a precinct

1 without a suitable polling place available, shall make space within
2 the facility available for use as a polling place upon the written
3 request of the secretary of the county election board.

4 C. For facilities described in subsection A or B of this
5 section, a reasonable maintenance or cleaning fee may be charged to
6 the county election board for use of the facility as a polling
7 place.

8 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2022.

9 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
10 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
11 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
12 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
