To file as a candidate for the State Senate in 14 any senatorial district, a person must have been a registered voter 15 in the district and a resident residing within such district for the 16 six-month period immediately preceding the first day of the filing 17 period as provided by law. Provided, however, to file as a 18 candidate for the Senate in any Senate district in 2022, a person 19 must have been a registered voter and a resident residing in such 20 district no later than December 31, 2021. Any member of the Senate 21 whose district has been changed by redistricting may change 22 residence with the intent of becoming qualified to seek reelection 23 in such district in the first election applicable to such district

3	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2022.
4	SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
5	of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
