6 An Act relating to motorized scooters; amending 47
7 O.S. 2021, Section 1-133.3, which relates to the
8 definition of a motorized scooter; modifying
9 definition; requiring minimum age to operate a
motorized scooter; requiring operator to observe all
applicable traffic safety regulations; and providing
an effective date.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2021, Section 1-133.3, is
13 amended to read as follows:

14 Section 1-133.3. Motorized scooter. A. A "motorized scooter"
15 is any vehicle having:

16 1. Not more than three wheels in contact with the ground;

17 2. Handlebars and a foot support or seat for the use of the
18 operator; and

19 3. A power source that is capable of propelling the vehicle at
20 a maximum design speed of not more than ~~twenty-five (25)~~ thirty (30)
21 miles per hour on level ground, and:

22 a. if the power source is a combustion engine, has a
23 piston or rotor displacement of ~~thirty-five~~ fifty
24 cubic centimeters ~~(35 cu cm)~~ (50 cu cm) or less

1 regardless of the number of chambers in the power
2 source, or

3 b. if the power source is electric, ~~has a power output of~~
4 ~~not more than one thousand (1,000) watts~~ is programmed
5 by the manufacturer not to exceed thirty (30) miles
6 per hour on level ground.

7 B. For purposes of this section, an electric personal assistive
8 mobility device, as defined in Section 1-114A of this title,
9 bicycle, electric-assisted bicycle, or motorized bicycle, as defined
10 in Section 1-104 of this title, shall not be considered a motorized
11 scooter.

12 C. A motorized scooter shall not be required to be registered
13 under the laws of this state. The operator of a motorized scooter
14 shall be at least fourteen (14) years of age and shall not be
15 required to possess a driver license or to comply with the vehicle
16 insurance or financial responsibility laws of this state and shall
17 observe all applicable traffic safety regulations.

18 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
