15	is any vehicle having:
16	1. Not more than three wheels in contact with the ground;
17	2. Handlebars and a foot support or seat for the use of the
18	operator; and
19	3. A power source that is capable of propelling the vehicle at
20	a maximum design speed of not more than <del>twenty-five (25)</del> thirty (30)
21	miles per hour on level ground, and:
22	a. if the power source is a combustion engine, has a
23	piston or rotor displacement of <del>thirty-five</del> <u>fifty</u>
24	cubic centimeters <del>(35 cu cm)</del> <u>(50 cu cm)</u> or less

1 regardless of the number of chambers in the power 2 source, or b. if the power source is electric, has a power output of 3 not more than one thousand (1,000) watts is programmed 4 5 by the manufacturer not to exceed thirty (30) miles per hour on level ground. 6 For purposes of this section, an electric personal assistive 7 В. mobility device, as defined in Section 1-114A of this title, 9 bicycle, electric-assisted bicycle, or motorized bicycle, as defined in Section 1-104 of this title, shall not be considered a motorized 10 scooter. 11 12 C. A motorized scooter shall not be required to be registered 13 under the laws of this state. The operator of a motorized scooter shall be at least fourteen (14) years of age and shall not be 14 required to possess a driver license or to comply with the vehicle 15 insurance or financial responsibility laws of this state and shall 16 17 observe all applicable traffic safety regulations.
