12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1135.2, as
14 last amended by Section 1, Chapter 434, O.S.L. 2019 (47 O.S. Supp.
15 2020, Section 1135.2), is amended to read as follows:

16 Section 1135.2. A. The Oklahoma Tax Commission is hereby
17 authorized to design and issue appropriate official special license
18 plates to persons in recognition of their service or awards as
19 provided by this section.

20 Special license plates shall not be transferred to any other
21 person but shall be removed from the vehicle upon transfer of
22 ownership and retained. The special license plate may then be used
23 on another vehicle but only after such other vehicle has been
24 registered for the current year.

1 Special license plates shall be renewed each year by the Tax
2 Commission or a motor license agent. The Tax Commission shall
3 annually notify by mail all persons issued special license plates.
4 The notice shall contain all necessary information and shall contain
5 instructions for the renewal procedure upon presentation to a motor
6 license agent or the Tax Commission. The license plates shall be
7 issued on a staggered system except for legislative plates and
8 amateur radio operator license plates.

9 The Tax Commission is hereby directed to develop and implement a
10 system whereby motor license agents are permitted to accept
11 applications for special license plates authorized under this
12 section. The motor license agent shall confirm the applicant's
13 eligibility, if applicable, collect and deposit any amount
14 specifically authorized by law, accept and process the necessary
15 information directly into such system and generate a receipt
16 accordingly. For performance of these duties, motor license agents
17 shall retain the fee provided in Section 1141.1 of this title for
18 registration of a motor vehicle. The motor license agent fees for
19 acceptance of applications and renewals shall be paid out of the
20 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund.

21 B. The special license plates provided by this section are as
22 follows:

23 1. Prisoner of War License Plates - such plates shall be
24 designed for honorably discharged or present members of the United

1 States Armed Forces and civilians who were former prisoners of war
2 held by a foreign country and who can provide proper certification
3 of that status. Such persons may apply for a prisoner of war
4 license plate for no more than two vehicles with each vehicle having
5 a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. The surviving
6 spouse of any deceased former prisoner of war, if the spouse has not
7 since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is terminated by
8 death, divorce, or annulment, may apply for a prisoner of war
9 license plate for one vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one
10 (1) ton or less. The fee provided by this section for the special
11 license plate authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to
12 all other registration fees provided by law, except the registration
13 fees levied by Section 1132 of this title;

14 2. National Guard License Plates - such plates shall be
15 designed for active or retired members of the Oklahoma National
16 Guard. Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide
17 proof of eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be
18 required to provide proof of eligibility annually;

19 3. Air National Guard License Plates - such plates shall be
20 designed for active or retired members of the Oklahoma Air National
21 Guard. Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide
22 proof of eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be
23 required to provide proof of eligibility annually;

1 4. United States Armed Forces - such plates shall be designed
2 for active, retired, former or reserve members of the United States
3 Armed Forces, and shall identify which branch of service, and carry
4 the emblem and name of either the Army, Navy, Air Force, Marines or
5 Coast Guard, according to the branch of service to which the member
6 belongs or did belong. Former members who have been dishonorably
7 discharged shall not be eligible for such plates. Persons applying
8 for such license plate must show proof of present or past military
9 service by presenting a valid Uniformed Services Identity Card or
10 the United States Department of Defense Form (DD)214. Retired or
11 former members who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof
12 of eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be required
13 to provide proof of eligibility annually;

14 5. Congressional Medal of Honor Recipient License Plates - such
15 plates shall be designed for any resident of this state who has been
16 awarded the Congressional Medal of Honor. Such persons may apply
17 for a Congressional Medal of Honor recipient license plate for each
18 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.
19 There shall be no registration fee for the issuance of this plate;

20 6. Missing In Action License Plates - such plates shall be
21 designed to honor members of the United States Armed Forces who are
22 missing in action. The spouse of such missing person, if the spouse
23 has not since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is
24 terminated by death, divorce, or annulment, and each parent of the

1 missing person may apply for a missing in action license plate upon
2 presenting proper certification that the person is missing in action
3 and that the person making the application is the qualifying spouse
4 or the parent of the missing person. The qualifying spouse and each
5 parent of the missing person may each apply for the missing in
6 action license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity
7 of one (1) ton or less;

8 7. Purple Heart Recipient License Plates - such plates shall be
9 designed for any resident of this state presenting proper
10 certification from the United States Department of Veterans Affairs
11 or the Armed Forces of the United States certifying that such
12 resident has been awarded the Purple Heart military decoration.
13 Such persons may apply for a Purple Heart recipient license plate
14 for vehicles having a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or
15 less. The surviving spouse of any deceased veteran who has been
16 awarded the Purple Heart military decoration, if such spouse has not
17 since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage has been terminated
18 by death, divorce or annulment, may apply for such plate for one
19 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. The
20 license plate created by this paragraph shall be exempt from the fee
21 provided by this section for special license plates;

22 8. Pearl Harbor Survivor License Plates - such plates shall be
23 designed for any resident of this state who can be verified by the
24

1 United States Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of
2 the United States as being:

- 3 a. a member of the United States Armed Forces on December
4 7, 1941,
- 5 b. stationed on December 7, 1941, during the hours of
6 7:55 a.m. to 9:45 a.m. Hawaii time at Pearl Harbor,
7 the island of Oahu, or offshore at a distance not to
8 exceed three (3) miles, and
- 9 c. a recipient of an honorable discharge from the United
10 States Armed Forces.

11 Such person may apply for a Pearl Harbor Survivor license plate
12 for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or
13 less;

14 9. Iwo Jima License Plates - such plates shall be designed for
15 any resident of this state who can be verified by the United States
16 Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of the United
17 States as being:

- 18 a. a member of the United States Armed Forces in February
19 of 1945,
- 20 b. stationed in February of 1945 on or in the immediate
21 vicinity of the island of Iwo Jima, and
- 22 c. a recipient of an honorable discharge from the United
23 States Armed Forces.

1 Such person may apply for an Iwo Jima license plate for each
2 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.

3 Such license plate shall have the legend "Oklahoma OK" and shall
4 contain three letters and three numbers. Between the letters and
5 numbers shall be a logo of the flag-raising at Iwo Jima. Below the
6 letters, logo and numbers, the plate shall contain the words "FEB."
7 at the left, "Iwo Jima" in the center and "1945" at the right. Such
8 plates shall not be subject to the design requirements of any other
9 license plates prescribed by law other than the space for the
10 placement of the yearly decals for each succeeding year of
11 registration after the initial issue;

12 10. D-Day Survivor License Plates - such plates shall be
13 designed for any resident of this state who can be verified by the
14 United States Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of
15 the United States as being:

- 16 a. a member of the United States Armed Forces on June 6,
17 1944,
- 18 b. a participant in the Allied invasion of the coast of
19 Normandy on June 6, 1944; provided, if such
20 participation cannot be verified by the United States
21 Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of
22 the United States, the Tax Commission may, in its
23 discretion, accept evidence of such participation from
24 the person applying for the license plate, and

1 c. a recipient of an honorable discharge from the United
2 States Armed Forces.

3 Such person may apply for a D-Day Survivor license plate for
4 each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

5 11. Killed in Action License Plates - such plates shall be
6 designed to honor members of the United States Armed Forces who were
7 killed in action. The spouse of the deceased person, if the spouse
8 has not remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is terminated by
9 death, divorce, or annulment, may apply for a killed in action
10 license plate upon presenting proper certification that the person
11 was killed in action and that the person making the application is
12 the qualifying spouse of the deceased person. The qualifying spouse
13 may apply for a killed in action license plate for no more than two
14 vehicles with each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1)
15 ton or less. The fee provided by this section for the special
16 license plate authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to
17 all other registration fees provided by law, except the registration
18 fees levied by Section 1132 of this title;

19 12. Gold Star Parents License Plates - such plates shall be
20 designed to honor members of the United States Armed Forces who were
21 killed during a war. The parents of the deceased person may apply
22 for a gold star license plate upon presenting proper certification
23 that the person was killed during a war and that the person making
24 the application is the parent of the deceased person. The parent

1 may apply for a gold star parent license plate for no more than two
2 vehicles with each vehicle having a rated carrying capacity of one
3 (1) ton or less. The fee provided by this section for the special
4 license plate authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to
5 all other registration fees provided by law, except the registration
6 fees levied by Section 1132 of this title;

7 13. Military Decoration License Plates - such plates shall be
8 designed for any resident of this state who has been awarded the
9 Distinguished Service Medal, the Distinguished Service Cross, the
10 Distinguished Flying Cross, the Bronze Star military decoration or
11 the Silver Star military decoration. Such persons may apply for a
12 military decoration license plate for each vehicle with a rated
13 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

14 14. Vietnam Veteran License Plates - such plates shall be
15 designed for honorably discharged or present members of the United
16 States Armed Forces who served in the Vietnam Conflict. Such
17 persons may apply for a Vietnam veteran license plate for each
18 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

19 15. Police Officer License Plates - such plates shall be
20 designed for any currently employed, reserve or retired municipal
21 police officer or full-time, reserve or retired university police
22 officer certified by the Council on Law Enforcement Education and
23 Training or common education police officer certified by the Council
24 on Law Enforcement Education and Training. Police officers may

1 apply for police officer license plates for vehicles with a rated
2 capacity of one (1) ton or less or for a motorcycle upon proof of
3 employment by or retirement from a municipal, university or common
4 education police department by either an identification card or
5 letter from the chief of the police department or the Oklahoma
6 Police Pension and Retirement Board. Retirees who are eligible for
7 such plates shall provide proof of eligibility upon initial
8 application, but shall not be required to provide proof of
9 eligibility annually. The license plates shall be designed in
10 consultation with municipal police departments of this state;
11 provided, the license plate for motorcycles may be of similar design
12 to the license plate for motor vehicles or may be a new design in
13 order to meet space requirements for a motorcycle license plate;

14 16. World War II Veteran License Plates - such plates shall be
15 designed to honor honorably discharged former members of the United
16 States Armed Forces who are residents of this state and who can be
17 verified by the Oklahoma Military Department, the Department of
18 Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of the United States as having
19 served on federal active duty anytime during the period from
20 September 16, 1940, to December 7, 1945. The former members may
21 apply for a World War II Veteran license plate for vehicles with a
22 rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.

23 The license plate shall have the legend "Oklahoma" and shall
24 contain, in the center of the plate, either the Thunderbird Insignia

1 of the 45th Infantry Division in the prescribed red and gold
2 coloring or the emblem of the Army, Navy, U.S. Army Air Corps,
3 Marines or Coast Guard according to the branch of service to which
4 the member belonged. For the purpose of license plate
5 identification, the plate shall contain four digits, two digits at
6 the left and two digits at the right of the insignia or emblem.
7 Centered on the bottom of the license plate shall be the words
8 "WORLD WAR II";

9 17. Korean War Veteran License Plates - such plates shall be
10 designed to honor honorably discharged former members of the United
11 States Armed Forces who are residents of this state and who can be
12 verified by the Oklahoma Military Department, the Department of
13 Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of the United States as having
14 served on federal active duty anytime during the period from June
15 27, 1950, to January 31, 1955, both dates inclusive. The former
16 members may apply for a Korean War Veteran license plate for
17 vehicles with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.

18 The license plate shall have the legend "OKLAHOMA" and shall
19 contain, in the center of the plate, either the Thunderbird Insignia
20 of the 45th Infantry Division in the prescribed red and gold
21 coloring or the emblem of the Army, Navy, Air Force, Marines or
22 Coast Guard according to the branch of service to which the member
23 belonged. For the purpose of license plate identification, the
24 plate shall contain four digits, two digits at the left and two

1 digits at the right of the insignia or emblem. Centered on the
2 bottom of the license plate shall be the word "KOREA";

3 18. Municipal Official License Plates - such plates shall be
4 designed for persons elected to a municipal office in this state and
5 shall designate the name of the municipality and the district or
6 ward in which the municipal official serves. The plates shall only
7 be produced upon application;

8 19. Red Cross Volunteer License Plates - such plates shall be
9 designed to honor American Red Cross volunteers and staff who are
10 residents of this state. Such persons must present an
11 identification card issued by the American Red Cross and bearing a
12 photograph of the person. The license plate shall be designed with
13 the assistance of the American Red Cross and shall have the legend
14 "Oklahoma OK!" in the color Pantone 186C Red. Below the legend the
15 symbol of the American Red Cross and no more than three letters and
16 three numbers shall be in the color Pantone 186C Red. Below the
17 symbol and letters and numbers shall be the words "American Red
18 Cross" in black. The plates shall not be subject to the design
19 requirements of any other license plates prescribed by law other
20 than the space for the placement of the yearly decals for each
21 succeeding year of registration after the initial issue;

22 20. Desert Storm License Plates - such plates shall be designed
23 and issued to any honorably discharged or present member of the
24 United States Armed Forces who served in the Persian Gulf Crisis and

1 the Desert Storm operation. Such persons may apply for a Desert
2 Storm license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity
3 of one (1) ton or less;

4 21. Military Reserve Unit License Plates - such plates shall be
5 designed and issued to any honorably discharged or present member of
6 a reserve unit of the United States Armed Forces. Such persons may
7 apply for a Military Reserve Unit license plate for each vehicle
8 with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

9 22. Oklahoma City Bombing Victims and Survivors License Plates
10 - such plates shall be designed and issued to any victim or survivor
11 of the bombing attack on the Alfred P. Murrah Federal Building in
12 downtown Oklahoma City on April 19, 1995;

13 23. Civil Air Patrol License Plates - such plates shall be
14 designed and issued to any person who is a member of the Civil Air
15 Patrol. Such persons may apply for a Civil Air Patrol license plate
16 for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or
17 less upon proof of membership in the Civil Air Patrol. The license
18 plate shall be designed in consultation with the Civil Air Patrol;

19 24. Ninety-Nines License Plates - such plates shall be designed
20 and issued to members of the Ninety-Nines. Persons applying for
21 such license plate must show proof of membership in the Ninety-
22 Nines. The license plates shall be designed in consultation with
23 the Ninety-Nines;

1 25. Combat Infantryman Badge License Plates - such plates shall
2 be designed to honor recipients of the Combat Infantryman Badge.
3 The plate shall have the legend "Oklahoma OK". Below the legend
4 shall be the Combat Infantryman Badge and three numbers. Below the
5 badge and the numbers shall be the words "Combat Infantryman Badge".
6 Such persons may apply for a Combat Infantryman Badge license plate
7 for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or
8 less;

9 26. Somalia Combat Veterans License Plates - such plates shall
10 be designed and issued to any honorably discharged or present member
11 of the United States Armed Forces who saw combat in the United
12 Nations relief effort. Such persons may apply for a Somalia Combat
13 Veteran license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying
14 capacity of one (1) ton or less;

15 27. Police Chaplain License Plates - such plates shall be
16 designed and issued to members of the International Conference of
17 Police Chaplains (ICPC) who have completed the ICPC requirements for
18 basic certification as a police chaplain. The license plates shall
19 be designed in consultation with the ICPC;

20 28. Joint Service Commendation Medal License Plates - such
21 plates shall be designed and issued to any resident of this state
22 who has been awarded the Joint Service Commendation Medal by the
23 United States Secretary of Defense;
24

1 29. Merchant Marine License Plates - such plates shall be
2 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission
3 by the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs, and issued to any
4 person who during combat was a member of the Merchant Marines as
5 certified by the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs. Such
6 license plate may be issued for each vehicle with a rated carrying
7 capacity of one (1) ton or less;

8 30. Legislative License Plates - such plates shall be designed
9 for persons elected to the Oklahoma Legislature and shall designate
10 the house of the Legislature in which the legislator serves and the
11 district number;

12 31. Disabled Veterans License Plates - such plates shall be
13 designed for persons presenting proper certification from the United
14 States Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of the
15 United States certifying such veteran has a service-connected
16 disability rating of fifty percent (50%) or more, regardless which
17 agency pays the disability benefits, or that such veteran has been
18 awarded a vehicle by the United States government or receives a
19 grant from the United States Department of Veterans Affairs for the
20 purchase of an automobile due to a service-connected disability
21 rating or due to the loss of use of a limb or an eye. Such persons
22 may apply to the Tax Commission for a disabled veterans license
23 plate or to a motor license agent for a regular license plate for no
24 more than two vehicles with each vehicle having a rated carrying

1 capacity of one (1) ton or less. The surviving spouse of any
2 deceased disabled veteran, if the spouse has not since remarried, or
3 if remarried, the remarriage is terminated by death, divorce, or
4 annulment, or a surviving spouse in receipt of Dependency and
5 Indemnity Compensation from the United States Department of Veterans
6 Affairs, may apply for a disabled veterans license plate for one
7 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. The
8 fee provided by this section for the special license plate
9 authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to all other
10 registration fees provided by law, except the registration fees
11 levied by Section 1132 of this title. The total expense of this
12 license plate shall not exceed Five Dollars (\$5.00).

13 If the person qualifies for a disabled veterans license plate
14 and is also eligible for a physically disabled placard under the
15 provisions of Section 15-112 of this title, the person shall be
16 eligible to receive a disabled veterans license plate that also
17 displays the international accessibility symbol, which is a stylized
18 human figure in a wheelchair. Upon the death of the disabled
19 veteran with a disabled veterans license plate with the
20 international accessibility symbol, the plate shall be returned to
21 the Tax Commission;

22 32. United States Air Force Association License Plates - such
23 plates shall be designed for members of the United States Air Force
24 Association. Persons applying for such license plate must show

1 proof of membership in the Association. The license plates shall be
2 designed in consultation with the Association;

3 33. Oklahoma Military Academy Alumni License Plates - such
4 plates shall be designed and issued to any resident of this state
5 who is an alumnus of the Oklahoma Military Academy. Such persons
6 may apply for an Oklahoma Military Academy Alumnus license plate for
7 each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.
8 The license plates shall be designed in consultation with the
9 Oklahoma Military Academy and shall contain the shield of the
10 Academy;

11 34. Amateur Radio Operator License Plates - such plates shall
12 be designed and issued to any person, holding a valid operator's
13 license, technician class or better, issued by the Federal
14 Communications Commission, and who is also the owner of a motor
15 vehicle currently registered in Oklahoma, in which has been
16 installed amateur mobile transmitting and receiving equipment.
17 Eligible persons shall be entitled to two special vehicle
18 identification plates as herein provided. Application for such
19 identification plates shall be on a form prescribed by the Tax
20 Commission and the plates issued to such applicant shall have
21 stamped thereon the word "Oklahoma" and bear the official call
22 letters of the radio station assigned by the Federal Communications
23 Commission to the individual amateur operator thereof. All
24 applications for such plates must be made to the Tax Commission on

1 or before the first day of October of any year for such plates for
2 the following calendar year and must be accompanied by the fee
3 required in this section together with a certificate, or such other
4 evidence as the Tax Commission may require, of proof that applicant
5 has a valid technician class or better amateur operator's license
6 and proof of applicant's ownership of a vehicle in which radio
7 receiving and transmitting equipment is installed. Applicants shall
8 only be entitled to one set of special identification plates in any
9 one (1) year, and such calendar year shall be stamped thereon. The
10 right to such special identification plates herein provided for
11 shall continue until the amateur radio operator's license of the
12 person to whom such plates are issued expires or is revoked;

13 35. American Legion License Plates - such plates shall be
14 designed for members of the American Legion. Persons applying for
15 such license plate must show proof of membership. The license
16 plates shall be designed in consultation with the American Legion of
17 Oklahoma;

18 36. Deputy Sheriff License Plates - such plates shall be
19 designed for any currently employed or retired county sheriff or
20 deputy sheriff. County sheriffs or deputy sheriffs may apply for
21 such plates for vehicles with a rated capacity of one (1) ton or
22 less upon proof of employment by or retirement from a county
23 sheriff's office by either an identification card or letter from the
24 county sheriff or a government-sponsored retirement board from which

1 the county sheriff or deputy sheriff may be receiving a pension.
2 Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof of
3 eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be required to
4 provide proof of eligibility annually. The license plates shall be
5 designed in consultation with the county sheriff offices of this
6 state;

7 37. Gold Star Surviving Spouse License Plates - such plates
8 shall be designed to honor the surviving spouses and children of
9 qualified veterans. As used in this paragraph, "qualified veteran"
10 shall mean:

- 11 a. any person honorably discharged from any branch of the
12 United States Armed Forces or as a member of the
13 Oklahoma National Guard, who died as a direct result
14 of the performance of duties for any branch of the
15 United States Armed Forces or Oklahoma National Guard
16 while on active military duty, or
- 17 b. any person honorably discharged from any branch of the
18 United States Armed Forces or as a member of the
19 Oklahoma National Guard, who died as a result of
20 injury, illness or disease caused by the performance
21 of such duties while on active duty, whether the death
22 occurred while on active duty or after the honorable
23 discharge of such person.

1 The fee provided by this section for the special license plate
2 authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to all other
3 registration fees provided by law, except the registration fees
4 levied by Section 1132 of this title;

5 38. Korea Defense Service Medal License Plates - such plates
6 shall be designed and issued to any resident of this state who has
7 been awarded the Korea Defense Service Medal by the United States
8 Secretary of Defense. Such persons may apply for a Korea Defense
9 Service Medal license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying
10 capacity of one (1) ton or less;

11 39. 180th Infantry License Plates - such plates shall be
12 designed for members and prior members of the 180th Infantry.
13 Persons applying for such license plate must obtain and provide
14 proof of their membership from the 180th Infantry Association. The
15 license plates shall be designed in consultation with the 180th
16 Infantry;

17 40. Operation Iraqi Freedom Veteran License Plates - such
18 plates shall be designed and issued to any honorably discharged or
19 present member of the United States Armed Forces who served in
20 Operation Iraqi Freedom. Such person may apply for an Operation
21 Iraqi Freedom Veteran license plate for each vehicle with a rated
22 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less, or for a motorcycle;
23 provided, the license plate for motorcycles may be of similar design
24

1 to the license plate for motor vehicles or may be a new design in
2 order to meet space requirements for a motorcycle license plate;

3 41. United States Air Force Academy Alumni License Plates -
4 such plates shall be designed and issued to any resident of this
5 state who is an alumnus of the United States Air Force Academy.
6 Such persons may apply for a United States Air Force Academy Alumnus
7 license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one
8 (1) ton or less;

9 42. Operation Enduring Freedom Veteran License Plate - such
10 plates shall be designed and issued to any honorably discharged or
11 present member of the United States Armed Forces who served in
12 Operation Enduring Freedom on or after September 11, 2001. The
13 license plate shall be designed in consultation with the Military
14 Department of the State of Oklahoma. Such person may apply for an
15 Operation Enduring Freedom Veteran license plate for each vehicle
16 with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less, or for a
17 motorcycle; provided, the license plate for motorcycles may be of
18 similar design to the license plate for motor vehicles or may be a
19 new design in order to meet space requirements for a motorcycle
20 license plate;

21 43. Military Multi-Decoration License Plate - such plates shall
22 be designed and issued to any honorably discharged or present member
23 of the United States Armed Forces who qualifies for more than one
24 military decoration license plate pursuant to the provisions of this

1 section. The Tax Commission shall develop and implement a system
2 whereby the designs of the eligible license plates can be included
3 together on a single license plate. Such person may apply for a
4 Military Multi-Decoration license plate for each vehicle with a
5 rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

6 44. Global War on Terror Expeditionary License Plate - such
7 plates shall be designed and issued to any honorably discharged or
8 present member of the United States Armed Forces who has earned a
9 Global War on Terror Expeditionary decoration. The license plate
10 shall be designed in consultation with the United States Institute
11 of Heraldry and the Military Department of the State of Oklahoma.
12 Such person may apply for a Global War on Terror Expeditionary
13 license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one
14 (1) ton or less;

15 45. Legion of Merit Medal Recipient License Plates - such
16 plates shall be designed for any resident of this state presenting
17 proper certification from the United States Department of Veterans
18 Affairs or the Armed Forces of the United States certifying that
19 such resident has been awarded the Legion of Merit military
20 decoration. Such persons may apply for a Legion of Merit recipient
21 license plate for vehicles having a rated carrying capacity of one
22 (1) ton or less. The license plate shall be designed in
23 consultation with the Military Department of the State of Oklahoma;

1 46. 1-179th License Plates - such plates shall be designed for
2 members, prior members and members of the household of a member or
3 former member of the 1-179th Infantry. Persons applying for such
4 license plate must obtain and provide proof of their membership
5 association with the 1-179th Infantry Association. The license
6 plate shall be designed in consultation with the 1-179th Infantry;

7 47. 2-179th License Plates - such plates shall be designed for
8 members, prior members and members of the household of a member or
9 former member of the 2-179th Infantry. Persons applying for such
10 license plate must obtain and provide proof of their membership
11 association with the 2-179th Infantry Association. The license
12 plate shall be designed in consultation with the 2-179th Infantry;

13 48. Combat Action Ribbon Recipient License Plates - such plates
14 shall be designed to honor recipients of the Combat Action Ribbon
15 who present proper certification from the United States Department
16 of the Navy. The license plate shall include the Combat Action
17 Ribbon earned by the recipient. Such persons may apply for a Combat
18 Action Ribbon Recipient license plate for vehicles having a rated
19 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

20 49. Oklahoma Submarine Veterans License Plate - such plates
21 shall be designed for any resident of this state who is a United
22 States submarine veteran and presents either a Department of Defense
23 form 214 or other documentation certifying such service. Such
24 persons may apply for an Oklahoma Submarine Veterans license plate

1 for vehicles having a rated capacity of one (1) ton or less. The
2 license plate design shall include both gold and silver dolphins to
3 represent both officer and enlisted service members;

4 50. United States Navy Seabees and Civil Engineer Corps License
5 Plate - such plates shall be designed and issued to any honorably
6 discharged or present member of the United States Navy Seabees or
7 Civil Engineer Corps. Such persons may apply for a United States
8 Navy Seabees and Civil Engineer Corps license plate for vehicles
9 having a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. The
10 license plate shall be designed in consultation with the Military
11 Department of the State of Oklahoma;

12 51. Combat Action Badge Recipient License Plate - such plates
13 shall be designed to honor recipients of the Combat Action Badge who
14 present proper certification from the United States Army. The
15 license plate shall include the Combat Action Badge earned by the
16 recipient. Such persons may apply for a Combat Action Badge
17 Recipient license plate for vehicles having a rated carrying
18 capacity of one (1) ton or less, or for a motorcycle; provided, the
19 license plate for motorcycles may be of similar design to the
20 license plate for motor vehicles or may be a new design in order to
21 meet space requirements for a motorcycle license plate;

22 52. Iraq Combat Veteran License Plate - such plates shall be
23 designed and issued to any honorably discharged or present member of
24 the United States Armed Forces who saw combat in Operation Iraqi

Freedom. Such persons may apply for an Iraq Combat Veteran license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less, or for a motorcycle; provided, the license plate for motorcycles may be of similar design to the license plate for motor vehicles or may be a new design in order to meet space requirements for a motorcycle license plate;

53. Afghanistan Combat Veteran License Plate - such plates shall be designed and issued to any honorably discharged or present member of the United States Armed Forces who saw combat in Operation Enduring Freedom. Such persons may apply for an Afghanistan Combat Veteran license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less, or for a motorcycle; provided, the license plate for motorcycles may be of similar design to the license plate for motor vehicles or may be a new design in order to meet space requirements for a motorcycle license plate; ~~and~~

54. Special Forces Association - such plates shall be designed and issued to any honorably discharged or present member of the Army Special Forces qualified and authorized to wear upon the person's United States military uniform the Army Special Forces Tab. Persons applying for the Special Forces Association license plate must provide a copy of the orders awarding the Special Forces Tab or authorizing its wear upon a United States military uniform. The license plate shall be designed in consultation with the Special Forces Association, Chapter 32-50. The Tax Commission shall produce

1 up to two distinct designs for the Special Forces Association
2 license plate. Qualified persons may select one design at the time
3 of application. The plates shall be issued to any qualified person
4 in any combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of
5 seven, as for personalized license plates;

6 55. Veterans of the United States Armed Forces - such plates
7 shall be designed for veterans of the United States Armed Forces,
8 and shall identify which branch of service, carry the emblem and
9 name of either the Army, Navy, Air Force, Marines or Coast Guard,
10 according to the branch of service to which the member belonged and
11 shall reflect veteran status. Former members who have been
12 dishonorably discharged shall not be eligible for such plates.
13 Persons applying for such license plate must show proof of past
14 military service by presenting a valid United States Department of
15 Defense Form (DD)214 upon initial application but shall not be
16 required to provide proof of eligibility annually; and

17 56. Navy Chief License Plate - such plates shall be designed
18 and issued to any resident of this state that has achieved the rank
19 of E7 through E9 in the United States Navy and that presents proper
20 certification that the resident has achieved such rank and was
21 either honorably discharged or is an active or retired member of the
22 United States Navy. Such persons may apply for a Navy Chief license
23 plate for vehicles having a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton
24 or less, or for a motorcycle; provided, the license plate for

1 motorcycles may be of similar design to the license plate for motor
2 vehicles or may be a new design in order to meet space requirements
3 for a motorcycle license plate.

4 C. Unless otherwise provided by this section, the fee for such
5 plates shall be Eight Dollars (\$8.00) and shall be in addition to
6 all other registration fees provided by the Oklahoma Vehicle License
7 and Registration Act. Such fees shall be deposited in the Oklahoma
8 Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund to be used for the administration
9 of the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act.

10 SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1135.5, as
11 last amended by Section 3, Chapter 434, O.S.L. 2019 (47 O.S. Supp.
12 2020, Section 1135.5), is amended to read as follows:

13 Section 1135.5. A. The Oklahoma Tax Commission is hereby
14 authorized to design and issue appropriate official special license
15 plates to persons wishing to demonstrate support and provide
16 financial assistance as provided by this section.

17 Special license plates shall not be transferred to any other
18 person but shall be removed from the vehicle upon transfer of
19 ownership and retained. The special license plate may then be used
20 on another vehicle but only after such other vehicle has been
21 registered for the current year with a motor license agent.

22 Special license plates shall be renewed each year by the Tax
23 Commission or a motor license agent, unless authorized by the Tax
24 Commission to be renewed for a period greater than one (1) year.

1 The Tax Commission shall notify by mail all persons issued special
2 license plates. The notice shall contain all necessary information
3 and shall contain instructions for the renewal procedure upon
4 presentation to a motor license agent or the Tax Commission. The
5 license plates shall be issued on a staggered system.

6 The Tax Commission is hereby directed to develop and implement a
7 system whereby motor license agents are permitted to accept
8 applications for special license plates authorized under this
9 section. The motor license agent shall confirm the applicant's
10 eligibility, if applicable, collect and deposit any amount
11 specifically authorized by law, accept and process the necessary
12 information directly into such system and generate a receipt
13 accordingly. For performance of these duties, motor license agents
14 shall retain the fee provided in Section 1141.1 of this title for
15 registration of a motor vehicle. The motor license agent fees for
16 acceptance of applications and renewals shall be paid out of the
17 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund.

18 If fewer than one hundred of any type of special license plates
19 authorized prior to January 1, 2004, are issued prior to January 1,
20 2006, the Tax Commission shall discontinue issuance and renewal of
21 that type of special license plate. Any such authorized special
22 license plate registrant shall be allowed to display the license
23 plate upon the designated vehicle until the registration expiration
24

1 date. After such time the expired special license plate shall be
2 removed from the vehicle.

3 For special license plates authorized on or after July 1, 2004,
4 no special license plates shall be developed or issued by the Tax
5 Commission until the Commission receives one hundred prepaid
6 applications therefor. The prepaid applications must be received by
7 the Tax Commission within one hundred eighty (180) days of the
8 effective date of the authorization or the authority to issue shall
9 be null and void. In the event one hundred prepaid applications are
10 not received by the Tax Commission within such prescribed time
11 period any payment so received shall be refunded accordingly.

12 B. The special license plates provided by this section are as
13 follows:

14 1. University or College Supporter License Plate - such plates
15 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
16 support to any state-supported or private university or college. As
17 provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be
18 apportioned as provided in Section 1104.1 of this title;

19 2. Environmental Awareness License Plate - such plates shall be
20 designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the Tax
21 Commission by the Department of Environmental Quality in
22 consultation with the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any
23 person wishing to demonstrate support to implement the statewide
24 general public environmental education program created pursuant to

1 the provisions of the Oklahoma Environmental Quality Code. Such
2 plates shall be designed and issued to any person in any combination
3 of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for
4 personalized license plates. A dealer's license plate issued
5 pursuant to Section 1116.1 or 1128 of this title may be designated
6 an Environmental Awareness License Plate upon payment of the fee
7 imposed by this section and any other registration fees required by
8 the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act. As provided in
9 this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned
10 pursuant to Section 1104.2 of this title;

11 3. Firefighter License Plate - such plates shall be designed
12 for any career or retired firefighter, volunteer or paid.
13 Firefighters may apply for firefighter plates for up to four
14 vehicles with a rated capacity of one (1) ton or less or for a
15 motorcycle upon proof of a fire department membership by either an
16 identification card or letter from the chief of the fire department.
17 Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof of
18 eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be required to
19 provide proof of eligibility annually. The surviving spouse of any
20 deceased firefighter, if the spouse has not since remarried, may
21 apply for a firefighter license plate for one vehicle with a rated
22 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less or for a motorcycle upon
23 proof that the deceased firefighter was a member of a fire
24 department by either an identification card or letter from the chief

1 of the fire department. The license plate shall be designed in
2 consultation with the Oklahoma Firefighters Association.

3 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
4 shall be deposited to the Oklahoma State Firemen's Museum Building &
5 Memorial Fund for support of the Oklahoma Firefighters Museum and
6 the Oklahoma Fallen and Living Firefighters Memorial;

7 4. Wildlife Conservation License Plate - such plates shall be
8 designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the Tax
9 Commission by the Oklahoma Department of Wildlife Conservation in
10 consultation with the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any
11 person wishing to demonstrate support for wildlife conservation in
12 this state through the Wildlife Diversity Fund, provided for in
13 Section 3-310 of Title 29 of the Oklahoma Statutes. Such plates may
14 be designed and issued to any person as for personalized license
15 plates.

16 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
17 shall be apportioned pursuant to subsection D of Section 3-310 of
18 Title 29 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

19 5. Child Abuse Prevention License Plate - such plates shall be
20 designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the Tax
21 Commission by the Office of Child Abuse Prevention in the State
22 Department of Health and the Oklahoma Committee to Prevent Child
23 Abuse, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
24 the prevention of child abuse.

1 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
2 shall be deposited in the Child Abuse Prevention Fund;

3 6. United States Olympic Committee Supporter License Plate -
4 such plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to
5 demonstrate support for the United States Olympic Committee. The
6 plates shall be issued to any person in any combination of numbers
7 and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized
8 license plates. The plate shall contain the official United States
9 Olympic Committee logo. The Tax Commission shall be authorized, if
10 necessary, to enter into a licensing agreement with the United
11 States Olympic Committee for any licensing fees which may be
12 required in order to use the United States Olympic Committee logo or
13 design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment of not
14 more than Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) for each license plate
15 issued;

16 7. Oklahoma History License Plate - such plates shall be
17 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate interest in
18 Oklahoma history. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee
19 collected shall be deposited to the Oklahoma Historical Society
20 Revolving Fund to be used for educational purposes;

21 8. Historic Route 66 License Plate - such:

22 a. vehicle plates shall be designed to honor historic
23 Route 66, also known as the "Mother Road". As
24 provided in this section, an amount of the fee

1 collected for each vehicle license plate shall be
2 apportioned to the Oklahoma Historical Society
3 Revolving Fund to be distributed to the Route 66
4 Museum located in Clinton, Oklahoma, and

5 b. motorcycle plates shall be designed in consultation
6 with the Oklahoma Route 66 Association, Inc. The
7 Oklahoma Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter
8 into a licensing agreement with the Oklahoma Route 66
9 Association, Inc., for any licensing fees which may be
10 required in order to use the Oklahoma Route 66
11 Association, Inc., logo or design. The licensing
12 agreement shall provide for a payment to the Oklahoma
13 Route 66 Association, Inc., of not more than Twenty
14 Dollars (\$20.00) for each motorcycle license plate
15 issued;

16 9. Heart of the Heartland License Plate - such plates shall be
17 designed and issued to any person wishing to honor the victims of
18 the terrorist bombing attack on the Alfred P. Murrah Federal
19 Building in downtown Oklahoma City on April 19, 1995. As provided
20 in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited
21 in the Heart of the Heartland Scholarship Fund, as established in
22 Section 2282 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

23 10. Emergency Medical Technician License Plate - such plates
24 shall be designed and issued to any person who is an emergency

1 medical technician. Such persons may apply for an emergency medical
2 technician license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying
3 capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of an emergency medical
4 technician's license. The license plate shall be designed in
5 consultation with the state association of emergency medical
6 technicians. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee
7 collected shall be apportioned to the Emergency Medical Personnel
8 Death Benefit Revolving Fund created in Section 1-2505.2 of Title 63
9 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

10 11. Fight Breast Cancer License Plate - such plates shall be
11 designed to demonstrate support for the prevention and treatment of
12 breast cancer in this state. As provided in this section, an amount
13 of the fee collected shall be apportioned to the Breast Cancer Act
14 Revolving Fund;

15 12. Crime Victims Awareness License Plate - such plates shall
16 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
17 awareness of and support for victims of crimes. The license plates
18 shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Crime Victims
19 Centre. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
20 shall be apportioned to the Attorney General's Revolving Fund for
21 the Office of the Attorney General, which is hereby directed to use
22 such funds to contract with a statewide nonprofit organization to
23 provide services to crime victims;

1 13. Oklahoma Safe Kids Association License Plate - such plates
2 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
3 support and awareness of the Oklahoma Safe Kids Association. The
4 license plate shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma
5 Safe Kids Association. As provided in this section, an amount of
6 the fee collected shall be deposited in the Children's Hospital -
7 Oklahoma Safe Kids Association Revolving Fund to be distributed to
8 the Oklahoma Safe Kids Association program;

9 14. Four-H Club License Plate - such plates shall be designed,
10 subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission by the
11 Four-H Foundation, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
12 support of the Four-H Club. Such plates may be designed and issued
13 to any person as for personalized license plates. As provided in
14 this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned to
15 the OSU Extension Service License Plate Revolving Fund created in
16 Section 1104.4 of this title;

17 15. Agricultural Awareness License Plate - such plates shall be
18 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission,
19 by the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry in
20 consultation with the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any
21 person wishing to demonstrate support of the Department's Ag in the
22 Classroom Education Program. As provided in this section, an amount
23 of the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in Section
24 1104.3 of this title;

1 16. Oklahoma Statehood Centennial License Plate - such plates
2 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to commemorate
3 the centennial of Oklahoma's admission to statehood in 1907. The
4 license plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma
5 Capitol Complex and Centennial Commemoration Commission. As
6 provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be
7 deposited in the Oklahoma Capitol Complex and Centennial
8 Commemoration Commission Revolving Fund created in Section 98.5 of
9 Title 73 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

10 17. Support Education License Plate - such plates shall be
11 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission
12 by the State Department of Education in consultation with the
13 Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any person wishing to
14 demonstrate support for education in this state. All motor license
15 agents shall display a sample of the Support Education License plate
16 in the area of the business accessed by the public. Twenty-three
17 Dollars (\$23.00) of the fee collected shall be apportioned as
18 follows:

- 19 a. five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the Education
20 Reform Revolving Fund,
- 21 b. five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the Higher
22 Education Revolving Fund,
- 23 c. five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the State
24 Career Technology Fund, and

1 d. eighty-five percent (85%) of the fee shall be
2 deposited to the Teachers' Retirement Benefit Fund as
3 set forth in Section 17-108 of Title 70 of the
4 Oklahoma Statutes.

5 However, when the Teachers' Retirement Benefit Fund attains a
6 seventy percent (70%) funded ratio based on an annual actuarial
7 valuation as required by law, the amount of the fee shall be
8 apportioned equally pursuant to subparagraphs a, b and c of this
9 paragraph;

10 18. Retired Oklahoma Highway Patrol Officers License Plate -
11 such plates shall be designed and issued to any retired officer of
12 the Oklahoma Highway Patrol. The license plate shall have the
13 legend "Oklahoma" and shall contain, in the center of the plate, the
14 Highway Patrol Officers patch using the same colors and pattern as
15 used in the patch. Centered on the bottom of the license plate
16 shall be the word "Retired". The letters "TRP" shall be used in
17 combination with three numbers on either side of the insignia or
18 emblem. The color of the letters and numbers shall be brown.
19 Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof of
20 eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be required to
21 provide proof of eligibility annually. The surviving spouse of any
22 deceased retired officer of the Oklahoma Highway Patrol, if the
23 spouse has not since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is
24 terminated by death, divorce, or annulment, may apply for a Retired

1 Oklahoma Highway Patrol Officers license plate. As provided in this
2 section, an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited into the
3 Law Enforcement Retirement Fund;

4 19. Boy Scouts of America Supporter License Plate - such plates
5 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
6 support for the Boy Scouts of America. The plates shall be issued
7 to any person in any combination of numbers and letters from one to
8 a maximum of seven, as for personalized license plates. The plate
9 shall contain the official Boy Scouts of America logo. The Tax
10 Commission shall be authorized, if necessary, to enter into a
11 licensing agreement with the Boy Scouts of America for any licensing
12 fees which may be required in order to use the Boy Scouts of America
13 logo or design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment
14 to the Boy Scouts of America of not more than Twenty Dollars
15 (\$20.00) for each license plate issued;

16 20. Urban Forestry and Beautification License Plate - such
17 plates shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the
18 Tax Commission, by the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and
19 Forestry in consultation with nonprofit organizations in this state
20 that develop and operate programs to encourage urban forestry and
21 beautification, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
22 support of such programs. As provided in this section, an amount of
23 the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in Section 1104.5
24 of this title;

1 21. Oklahoma State Parks Supporter License Plate - such plates
2 shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax
3 Commission by the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department, and
4 issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the Oklahoma
5 state parks system. Twenty-three Dollars (\$23.00) of the fee
6 collected shall be deposited in the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation
7 Department Revolving Fund. Such money shall be designated for and
8 may only be expended for the support of Oklahoma state parks;

9 22. Adoption Creates Families License Plate - such plates shall
10 be issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support of pregnant
11 women who are committed to placing their children for adoption and
12 wishing to provide assistance to guardians, adoptive parents and
13 other created families to assist in the adoption and placement of
14 children in permanent, safe homes. The license plates shall be
15 designed and final terminology delivered in consultation with the
16 Oklahoma Adoption Coalition and the Department of Human Services.
17 Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) of the fee collected shall be deposited
18 in a revolving fund established in the State Treasury for and to be
19 used by the Department of Human Services for the implementation of
20 the Investing in Stronger Oklahoma Families Act specifically for
21 created families;

22 23. Choose Life License Plate - such plates shall be designed,
23 subject to criteria presented to the Tax Commission, by Choose Life,
24 Inc., and issued to any person who wishes to demonstrate support of

1 organizations that encourage adoption as a positive choice for women
2 with unplanned pregnancies. As provided in this section, an amount
3 of the fee collected shall be deposited in the Choose Life
4 Assistance Program Revolving Fund established in Section 1104.6 of
5 this title;

6 24. Future Farmers of America License Plate - such plates shall
7 be designed and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for
8 the Oklahoma FFA (formerly known as Future Farmers of America). The
9 license plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma
10 FFA Foundation Board of Directors. As provided in this section, an
11 amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in
12 Section 1104.7 of this title;

13 25. Lions Club License Plate - such plates shall be designed
14 and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for the Lions
15 Club of Oklahoma. The plates shall be issued to any person in any
16 combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven,
17 as for personalized license plates. The license plates shall be
18 designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Lions Service Foundation
19 and shall contain the official logo of the International Association

15 the official Girl Scouts of the United States of America logo. The
16 Tax Commission shall be authorized, if necessary, to enter into a
17 licensing agreement with the Girl Scouts of the United States of
18 America for any licensing fees which may be required in order to use
19 the Girl Scouts of the United States of America logo or design. The
20 licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to the Girl Scouts
21 of Magic Empire Council, acting on behalf of all Oklahoma Girl Scout
22 councils, of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license
23 plate issued;

1 28. Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon License Plate - such plates
2 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
3 support for the Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon. The plate shall be
4 designed in consultation with the Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon.

9 "Support Our Troops" across the bottom of the plate. The Tax
10 Commission, if necessary, may enter into a licensing agreement with
11 Support Our Troops Incorporated for any licensing fees which may be
12 required in order to use the Support Our Troops Incorporated logo or
13 design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to
14 Support Our Troops Incorporated of Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) for
15 each license plate issued;

16 40. Folds of Honor Supporter License Plate - such plates shall
17 be authorized to be designed and issued to any person wishing to
18 demonstrate support for the Oklahoma City Chapter of Folds of Honor
19 Incorporated, a nonprofit charitable organization exempt from
20 taxation pursuant to the provisions of the Internal Revenue Code, 26
21 U.S.C., Section 501(c)(3), providing educational scholarships to
22 spouses and children of America's fallen and disabled military
23 service members. The plates shall be issued to any person in any

15 with Sooner State ABATE. The plates shall be issued to any person
16 in any combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of
17 seven, as for personalized plates. The license plate for a
18 motorcycle may be of similar design as space permits or a new design
19 in order to meet the space requirements of a motorcycle license
20 plate. The Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter into a
21 licensing agreement with Sooner State ABATE for any licensing fees,
22 which may be required in order to use the association's logo or
23 design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to
24 Sooner State ABATE of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each

15 the Oklahoma Historical Society. As provided in this section, an
16 amount of the fee collected shall be deposited in the Oklahoma
17 Historical Society Capital Improvement and Operations Revolving Fund
18 created in Section 1.10a of Title 53 of the Oklahoma Statutes. The
19 Tax Commission shall create and maintain a list of former members of
20 the Oklahoma House of Representatives and Oklahoma State Senate

23 Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license plate issued;

1 94. Veterans of Foreign Wars License Plate - such plates shall
2 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support
3 for the Veterans of Foreign Wars Foundation. The license plates
4 shall be designed in consultation with the Veterans of Foreign Wars
5 Foundation. The Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter into a
6 licensing agreement with the Veterans of Foreign Wars Foundation for
7 any licensing fees which may be required in order to use the
8 foundation's logo or design. The licensing agreement shall provide
9 for a payment to the Veterans of Foreign Wars Foundation of not more
10 than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license plate issued. The
11 licensing fee may be paid to the Oklahoma Chapter of the Veterans of
12 Foreign Wars if such an arrangement is made under the licensing
13 agreement;

14 95. Oklahoma Women Veterans Organization License Plate - such
15 plates shall be designed and issued to any female veteran of any
16 branch of the United States Armed Forces wishing to demonstrate
17 support for the Oklahoma Women Veterans Organization. The license
18 plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Women
19 Veterans Organization. The Tax Commission shall be authorized to
20 enter into a licensing agreement with the Oklahoma Women Veterans
21 Organization for any licensing fees which may be required in order
22 to use the organization's logo or design. The licensing agreement
23 shall provide for a payment to the Oklahoma Women Veterans

1 Organization of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each

22 100. Epilepsy Foundation License Plate - such plates shall be
23 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for

2 Commission shall be authorized to enter into a licensing agreement
3 with the Epilepsy Foundation for any licensing fees which may be
4 required in order to use the organization's logo or design. The
5 licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to the Epilepsy
6 Foundation of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license
7 plate issued; and

8 101. America First License Plate - such plates shall be
9 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
10 the proclamation of "America First". The license plates shall be
11 designed in consultation with Warriors for Freedom and the Honoring
12 America's Warriors Foundations. The Tax Commission shall be
13 authorized to enter into a licensing agreement with the Warriors for
14 Freedom and Honoring America's Warriors Foundations for any
15 licensing fees which may be required in order to use the
16 Foundations' logos or designs. The licensing agreement shall
17 provide for a payment to the Honoring America's Warriors Foundation
18 of not more than Ten Dollars (\$10.00) and a payment to the Warriors
19 for Freedom Foundation of not more than Ten Dollars (\$10.00) for
20 each license plate issued.

21 C. The fee for such plates shall be Thirty-five Dollars
22 (\$35.00) per year of renewal and shall be in addition to all other
23 registration fees provided by the Oklahoma Vehicle License and
24 Registration Act. The fee shall be apportioned as follows:

1. Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) per year of renewal or any other amount as provided in this title of the fee shall be apportioned as provided or deposited in a fund as specified within the paragraph authorizing the special license plate;

2. Eight Dollars (\$8.00) per year of renewal of the fee shall be deposited in the Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund to be used for the administration of the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act; and

3. Any remaining amounts of the fee shall be apportioned as provided in Section 1104 of this title.

SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2021.
