The 15 Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers 16 17 bearing that name to be placed on the bridge. A new section of law to be codified SECTION 2. NEW LAW 18 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.366 of Title 69, unless 19 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: 20 The bridge over Walnut Creek on State Highway 24, east of the 21 town of Washington in McClain County, shall be designated as the 22 "SSGT Jerry Michael Chitwood Memorial Bridge". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the highway.

SECTION 6. A new section of law to be codified 7 NEW LAW in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.370 of Title 69, unless 8 9 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: 10 The bridge at the interchange of U.S. Highway 81 and State Highway 7 running southwest to northeast in Stephens County shall be 11 designated as the "SSG Rodney Aaron Hagan Memorial Bridge". 12 The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers 13 bearing that name to be placed on the bridge. 14

NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified 15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.371 of Title 69, unless 16 17 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: The portion of U.S. Highway 75 beginning at the intersection of 18 E 106th Street N and ending at the intersection of E 116th Street N 19 in Tulsa County shall be designated as the "OHP Captain Larry 20 Jackson Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation shall 21 cause suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on 22 the highway. 23

NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.372 of Title 69, unless 2 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: 3 The Section of U.S. Highway 70, near the southeast edge of 4 5 Durant beginning at McLean Road and extending northeasterly two and one-half miles, in Bryan County, shall be designated the "Hunter 6 Ford, Fernando Flores, Jack Sarver, and Kaleb Foster Memorial 7 Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable 8 9 permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the highway. A new section of law to be codified 10 SECTION 9. NEW LAW in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.373 of Title 69, unless 11 12 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: The bridge crossing over U.S. Highway 69 on U.S. Highway 70, on 13 the south side of Durant in Bryan County, shall be designated the 14 "Senator Billy A. Mickle Memorial Bridge". The Department of 15 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that 16 17 name to be placed on the bridge. SECTION 10. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified 18

in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.374 of Title 69, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: The bridge over Wolf Creek on U.S. Highway 283 north of Shattuck in Ellis County shall be designated the "Undersheriff Monty Martin Memorial Bridge". The Department of Transportation shall cause

The Department of Transportation shall 10 cause suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on 11 the highway.

NEW LAW in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.766 of Title 69, unless 13 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: 14 The bridge on U.S. Highway 412 crossing over State Highway 88 15 near Inola in Rogers County shall be designated the "PFC Travis J. 16 Grigg 101st Airborne Division Memorial Bridge". The Department of 17 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that 18
