6 [memorial highway and bridge designations - Private
7 Robert "Bob" Clark Memorial Bridge - effective date]

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

10 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
11 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.365 of Title 69, unless
12 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

13 The bridge located on U.S. Highway 81, approximately one mile
14 south of the State Highway 19 West intersection, in Grady County
15 shall be designated as the "SGT Mycal Prince Memorial Bridge". The
16 Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers
17 bearing that name to be placed on the bridge.

18 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
19 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.366 of Title 69, unless
20 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

21 The bridge over Walnut Creek on State Highway 24, east of the
22 town of Washington in McClain County, shall be designated as the
23 "SSGT Jerry Michael Chitwood Memorial Bridge". The Department of
24

1 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that
2 name to be placed on the bridge.

3 SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
4 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.367 of Title 69, unless
5 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

6 The section of U.S. Highway 266 beginning at the intersection of
7 Porter Road, extending northeasterly to the intersection of County
8 Road N4030 in Okmulgee County, shall be designated the "SP-4 Wilbert
9 Gresham Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation shall
10 cause suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on
11 the highway.

12 SECTION 4. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
13 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.368 of Title 69, unless
14 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

15 The section of State Highway 51 beginning at the intersection of
16 Country Club Road and extending west to the intersection of Karsten
17 Creek Road in Payne County shall be designated as the "Boone Pickens
18 Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause
19 suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the
20 highway.

21 SECTION 5. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
22 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.669 of Title 69, unless
23 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

1 The section of Interstate 44 beginning one-half mile north of
2 State Highway 36 interchange extending south to U.S. Highway 70
3 interchange, in Cotton County, shall be designated the "William Mark
4 Miller Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation shall
5 cause suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on
6 the highway.

7 SECTION 6. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
8 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.370 of Title 69, unless
9 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

10 The bridge at the interchange of U.S. Highway 81 and State
11 Highway 7 running southwest to northeast in Stephens County shall be
12 designated as the "SSG Rodney Aaron Hagan Memorial Bridge". The
13 Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers
14 bearing that name to be placed on the bridge.

15 SECTION 7. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
16 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.371 of Title 69, unless
17 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

18 The portion of U.S. Highway 75 beginning at the intersection of
19 E 106th Street N and ending at the intersection of E 116th Street N
20 in Tulsa County shall be designated as the "OHP Captain Larry
21 Jackson Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation shall
22 cause suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on
23 the highway.

1 SECTION 8. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
2 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.372 of Title 69, unless
3 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

4 The Section of U.S. Highway 70, near the southeast edge of
5 Durant beginning at McLean Road and extending northeasterly two and
6 one-half miles, in Bryan County, shall be designated the "Hunter
7 Ford, Fernando Flores, Jack Sarver, and Kaleb Foster Memorial
8 Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable
9 permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the highway.

10 SECTION 9. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
11 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.373 of Title 69, unless
12 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

13 The bridge crossing over U.S. Highway 69 on U.S. Highway 70, on
14 the south side of Durant in Bryan County, shall be designated the
15 "Senator Billy A. Mickle Memorial Bridge". The Department of
16 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that
17 name to be placed on the bridge.

18 SECTION 10. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
19 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.374 of Title 69, unless
20 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

21 The bridge over Wolf Creek on U.S. Highway 283 north of Shattuck
22 in Ellis County shall be designated the "Undersheriff Monty Martin
23 Memorial Bridge". The Department of Transportation shall cause
24

1 suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the
2 bridge.

3 SECTION 11. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
4 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.675 of Title 69, unless
5 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

6 The section of Interstate 35 beginning at the U.S. Highway 77
7 interchange extending north to the State Highway 33 interchange near
8 Guthrie in Logan County shall be designated the "Clarence and Ethel
9 Branch Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation shall
10 cause suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on
11 the highway.

12 SECTION 12. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
13 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.766 of Title 69, unless
14 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

15 The bridge on U.S. Highway 412 crossing over State Highway 88
16 near Inola in Rogers County shall be designated the "PFC Travis J.
17 Grigg 101st Airborne Division Memorial Bridge". The Department of
18 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that
19 name to be placed on the bridge.

20 SECTION 13. AMENDATORY 69 O.S. 2021, Section 1698.300,
21 is amended to read as follows:

22 Section 1698.300. ~~The section of U.S. Highway 277 beginning on~~
23 ~~the west side of the H.E. Bailey Turnpike and extending west to the~~
24 ~~intersection of U.S. Highway 62 in Comanche County~~ bridge crossing

1 over the Arkansas River on Interstate 244 in Tulsa County, shall be
2 designated as the "Gold Star Families Memorial ~~Highway~~ Bridge". The
3 Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers
4 bearing that name to be placed on the ~~highway~~ bridge.

5 SECTION 14. AMENDATORY 69 O.S. 2021, Section 1698.310,
6 is amended to read as follows:

7 Section 1698.310. The bridge over the Cimarron River ~~on Highway~~
8 ~~15 approximately thirteen (13) miles north of Boise City~~ located on
9 U.S. Highway 287, five (5) miles south of the Oklahoma/Colorado
10 state line in Cimarron County shall be designated as the "Private
11 Robert "Bob" Clark Memorial Bridge". The Department of
12 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that
13 name to be placed on the bridge.

14 SECTION 15. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
