6 An Act relating to public finance; requiring signage
7 be placed on certain projects; providing for
8 codification; and providing an effective date.

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

10 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
11 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 34.701 of Title 62, unless there
12 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

13 All infrastructure or construction projects in this state that
14 are visible to the public and that are funded partially or fully by
15 the Joint Committee on Pandemic Relief Funding shall have signage
16 displayed in a prominently visible location at the project site. It
17 is the intent of the Legislature that such signage reference the
18 COVID-19 Recovery and Resilience Initiative, the Joint Committee on
19 Pandemic Relief Funding, and the year completed. The Office of
20 Management and Enterprise Services shall be authorized to implement
21 the provisions of this section. The Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation
22 Department shall oversee the design and placement of any such
23 signage on each project.

24 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
