NEW LAW in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 34.701 of Title 62, unless there 11 12 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: 13 All infrastructure or construction projects in this state that are visible to the public and that are funded partially or fully by 14 the Joint Committee on Pandemic Relief Funding shall have signage 15 displayed in a prominently visible location at the project site. It 16 is the intent of the Legislature that such signage reference the 17 COVID-19 Recovery and Resilience Initiative, the Joint Committee on 18 Pandemic Relief Funding, and the year completed. The Office of 19 Management and Enterprise Services shall be authorized to implement 20 the provisions of this section. The Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation 21 Department shall oversee the design and placement of any such 22 signage on each project. 23 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022. 24
