The Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services and the Commissioner of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services are authorized to fix the maximum amount of <u>each the petty cash fund</u>. The Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services shall prescribe the rules and procedures for the administration of <u>each the petty cash fund</u>.</u>
- C. The Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services is authorized to effect the transfer of property, records, equipment, supplies, funds, and encumbrances from Griffin Memorial Hospital to or from the Norman Alcohol and Drug Treatment Center; and to effect the transfer of property, records, equipment, supplies, funds, and encumbrances from the Oklahoma Forensic Center to or from the Rose Rock Recovery Center at Vinita.
- 19 SECTION 3. REPEALER 43A O.S. 2011, Section 3-106, as
  20 amended by Section 148, Chapter 304, O.S.L. 2012 (43A O.S. Supp.
  21 2020, Section 3-106), is hereby repealed.
