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11	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
12	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 68 O.S. 2021, Section 6005, is
13	amended to read as follows:
14	Section 6005. A. For fiscal years beginning prior to July 1,
15	1999, all revenues derived pursuant to the provisions of Sections
16	6001 through 6007 of this title shall be paid monthly by the
17	Oklahoma Tax Commission to the State Treasurer and placed to the
18	credit of the General Revenue Fund to be paid out pursuant to direct
19	appropriation by the Legislature.
20	B. 1. For the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1999, fifty
21	percent (50%) of all revenues derived pursuant to the provisions of
22	Sections 6001 through 6007 of this title shall be paid monthly by
23	the Tax Commission to the State Treasurer and placed to the credit
24	of the General Revenue Fund to be paid out pursuant to direct

1 appropriation by the Legislature, and fifty percent (50%) of the 2 revenues shall be placed to the credit of the Oklahoma Aeronautics 3 Commission Revolving Fund.

For fiscal year 2001 through fiscal year 2015 For the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2022, and all subsequent fiscal years, one hundred percent (100%) of the revenues derived pursuant to the provisions of Sections 6001 through 6007 of this title shall be paid monthly by the <u>Oklahoma</u> Tax Commission to the State Treasurer and shall be placed to the credit of the Oklahoma Aeronautics Commission Revolving Fund.

3. For the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2015, and for each 11 fiscal year thereafter, the first Four Million Five Hundred Thousand 12 Dollars (\$4,500,000.00) of the revenues each fiscal year derived 13 pursuant to the provisions of Sections 6001 through 6007 of this 14 title shall be paid by the Tax Commission to the State Treasurer and 15 placed to the credit of the Oklahoma Aeronautics Commission 16 Revolving Fund, and all such revenues derived each fiscal year in 17 excess of Four Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$4,500,000.00) 18 shall be paid by the Tax Commission to the State Treasurer and 19 placed to the credit of the General Revenue Fund to be paid out 20 pursuant to direct appropriation by the Legislature. 21 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2022. 22 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation 23 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby 24
