8	disturbance, interference or disruption of state business; modifying entity inclusions; and declaring
9	an emergency.

12	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
13	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 21 O.S. 2011, Section 280, is
14	amended to read as follows:
15	Section 280. A. It is unlawful for any person, alone or in
16	concert with others and without authorization, to willfully disturb,
17	interfere or disrupt state business or the business of any political
18	subdivision, which includes publicly posted meetings, or any agency
19	operations or any employee, agent, official or representative of the
20	state or political subdivision.
21	B. It is unlawful for any person who is without authority or
22	who is causing any disturbance, interference or disruption to
23	willfully refuse to disperse or leave any property, building or
24	structure owned, leased or occupied by state officials or any

political subdivision or its, employees, agents or representatives or used in any manner to conduct state business or any political subdivision's business or operations after proper notice by a peace officer, sergeant-at-arms, or other security personnel.

- C. Any violation of the provisions of this section shall be a misdemeanor punishable by imprisonment in the county jail for a term of not more than one (1) year, by a fine not exceeding One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00), or by both such fine and imprisonment.
- D. For purposes of this section, "disturb, interfere or disrupt" means any conduct that is violent, threatening, abusive, obscene, or that jeopardizes the safety of self or others.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this resolution shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
