9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

10 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Department of  
11 Public Safety from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the  
12 General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year  
13 ending June 30, 2023, the sum of One Hundred Thousand Dollars  
14 (\$100,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the  
15 duties imposed upon the Department of Public Safety by law.

16 SECTION 2. Appropriations made by Section 1 of this act, not  
17 including appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be  
18 budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2023 (hereafter FY-23)  
19 or may be budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2024  
20 (hereafter FY-24). Funds budgeted for FY-23 may be encumbered only  
21 through June 30, 2023 and must be expended by November 15, 2023.  
22 Any funds remaining after November 15, 2023, and not budgeted for  
23 FY-24, shall lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then  
24 current fiscal year. Funds budgeted for FY-24 may be encumbered

1 only through June 30, 2024. Any funds remaining after November 15,  
2 2024, shall lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then  
3 current fiscal year. These appropriations may not be budgeted in  
4 both fiscal years simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-23, and not  
5 required to pay obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted  
6 for FY-24, after the agency to which the funds have been  
7 appropriated has prepared and submitted a budget work program  
8 revision removing these funds from the FY-23 budget work program and  
9 after such revision has been approved by the Office of Management  
10 and Enterprise Services.
