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11	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
12	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2011, Section 5060.6, is
13	amended to read as follows:
14	Section 5060.6. A. The board of directors for the Oklahoma
15	Center for the Advancement of Science and Technology (OCAST) is
16	hereby reconstituted as the Oklahoma Science and Technology Research
17	(OSTRaD) and Development (OSTRaD) Board shall consist of eleven (11)
18	members and shall be comprised as follows:
19	1. The Director of the Oklahoma Department of Commerce <u>Two</u>
20	members appointed by the Governor, with the advice and consent of
21	the Senate;
22	2. The Chancellor of the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher
23	Education Three members appointed by the President Pro Tempore of
24	the Senate;

1	3. The president of the University of Oklahoma Three members
2	appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives;
3	4. The president of Oklahoma State University;
4	5. The president of one of the regional universities in The
5	State System of Higher Education designated by the Chancellor; <u>Two</u>
6	members appointed by the Chancellor of The State System of Higher
7	Education; and
8	6. The president of a private Oklahoma university classified by
9	the Carnegie Foundation as a national doctorate-granting institution
10	offering graduate engineering degrees to be appointed by the
11	Governor;
12	7. The Covernor's appointed cabinet Secretary of Agriculture;
13	8. A member of the House of Representatives, who shall serve as
14	an ex officio nonvoting member, appointed by the Speaker of the
15	House of Representatives;
16	9. A member of the Senate, who shall serve as an ex officio
17	nonvoting member, appointed by the President Pro Tempore of the
18	Senate;
19	10. Two members, appointed by the Governor, who shall be
20	engineers or scientists with extensive experience in managing basic
21	or applied scientific or technological research at Oklahoma
22	institutions of higher education, who shall serve terms of four (4)
23	years; provided that, the two members who possess these
24	qualifications and are serving on the board of directors of the

Center on July 1, 2002, shall fill these positions on the Oklahoma Science and Technology Research and Development Board for initial terms to expire on June 30, 2003;

11. Five members appointed by the Covernor who are or who have 4 5 served as chief executive officers or senior executive officers of corporations engaged in information technology, biotechnology, 6 7 genetics, other emerging technologies, agriculture, oil and natural gas, early stage high risk venture capital finance, other 8 9 significant Oklahoma industries, or Oklahoma industries that are 10 potentially significant to the state economy or who are or who have served as chief executive officers or senior executive officers of a 11 12 private nonprofit organization or who are or who have served as chief executive officers or senior executive officers of foundations 13 with a history of supporting research and development. Two members 14 15 appointed pursuant to this paragraph shall serve initial terms to expire on June 30, 2005, and two shall serve initial terms to expire 16 on June 30, 2006. For the position for which the initial 17 appointment begins after July 1, 2005, the initial term shall expire 18 on June 30, 2009; 19 12. Four members appointed by the Covernor who represent small 20 business. One appointee shall serve an initial term to expire on 21 June 30, 2005, and one shall serve an initial term to expire on June 22 30, 2006. For the two positions for which the initial appointments 23 begin after July 1, 2005, one appointee shall serve an initial term 24

1 to expire on June 30, 2008, and one appointee shall serve an initial
2 term to expire on June 30, 2009;

3 13. One member appointed by the Governor who represents rural 4 Oklahoma. The initial appointee shall serve a term to expire on 5 June 30, 2004; and

14. Until June 30, 2004, or vacation of the offices, six 6 members who, before the effective date of this act, were appointed 7 by the Governor and who are serving on the board of directors of 8 9 OCAST on July 1, 2002. These positions on the Oklahoma Science and 10 Technology Research and Development Board shall cease to exist on 11 June 30, 2004, or when the position is vacated if the vacancy occurs prior to June 30, 2004. A member of the OCAST board who holds one 12 13 of these positions may be appointed to a position described in paragraphs 9 through 12 of this subsection on the Oklahoma Science 14 15 and Technology Research and Development Board if the member meets 16 the qualifications for such position. B. The two legislatively appointed members of the Board shall 17 be persons of demonstrated knowledge of and commitment to the 18 advancement of science and technology in Oklahoma and shall serve at 19 the pleasure of their respective appointing authority 20 5. The Secretary of Science and Innovation. 21 The Secretary of Science and Innovation shall serve as 22 Β. chair. 23

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C. In making appointments to the Oklahoma Science and
 Technology Research and Development Board, appropriate consideration
 shall be given to representation upon the Board by race, gender and
 geographical area.

D. Gubernatorial appointees appointed after July 1, 2002, shall 5 serve four-year terms except for initial terms as provided in this 6 section. Terms shall expire on June 30. All gubernatorial 7 appointees shall be subject to confirmation by the Senate. Except 8 9 as otherwise provided in this section, any vacancy in board 10 positions filled by appointment of the Governor shall be filled for 11 the unexpired term in the same manner as the original appointment With the exception of the Secretary of Science and Innovation, all 12 13 members shall be appointed for a term of (4) years.

E. The Board shall elect, annually, a chair who shall be from
the private sector membership of the Board. A vice-chair shall be
elected annually from among all the members of the Board. Persons
elected to the position of chair or vice-chair shall not serve more
than two consecutive terms in said position.

19 F. The Board shall meet at least once each calendar quarter and 20 at such other times:

21 1. Upon call of the chair;

22 2. Upon call of the chief executive officer of the Center or23 the Institute; or

24 3. Upon written request of a majority of the board members.

1 G. F. A majority of the six voting members of the Board shall constitute a quorum. A quorum of the Board shall be necessary to 2 transact business. All actions of the board members shall be made 3 by a majority of the quorum present. A board member appointed 4 5 pursuant to paragraphs 3, 4, 5 or 6 of subsection A of this section may send a predetermined designee as a representative to board 6 meetings who may participate with full voting privileges. All other 7 board members may send a predetermined designee as a representative 8 9 to board meetings who may vote; provided, the designee may vote at no more than thirty percent (30%) of meetings during a fiscal year. 10 H. Members of the Board shall be entitled to compensation and 11 12 expenses as may be provided in the charter or bylaws of the Board. The members of the Board shall not be subject to the dual-13 G. office-holding prohibitions set forth in Section 6 of Title 51 of 14 the Oklahoma Statutes. 15 I. The Board shall establish an executive committee composed of 16 the chair, vice-chair, and three (3) additional voting members 17 chosen by the chair from among the remaining board members. The 18 executive committee, in intervals between board meetings, may 19 transact any board business that has been delegated to the executive 20 committee. A majority of the executive committee shall be necessary 21 to transact business and all actions of the executive committee 22 shall be by a majority vote of the committee. 23 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2021. 24
