10	SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Department of

13	Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2023, the sum of One
14	Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00) or so much thereof as may be

1	current fiscal year. Funds budgeted for FY-24 may be encumbered
2	only through June 30, 2024. Any funds remaining after November 15,
3	2024, shall lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then
4	current fiscal year. These appropriations may not be budgeted in
5	both fiscal years simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-23, and not
6	required to pay obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted
7	for FY-24, after the agency to which the funds have been
8	appropriated has prepared and submitted a budget work program
9	revision removing these funds from the FY-23 budget work program and
10	after such revision has been approved by the Office of Management
11	and Enterprise Services.
