Supp. 12 2020, Sections 1132, 1135.1, 1135.2, 1135.3, 1135.4, 1135.5, 1135.7 and 1141.1), which relate to issuance of special or personalized license plates; 13 authorizing combination of registration periods after specified date; requiring related rulemaking by 14 Oklahoma Tax Commission; requiring single remittance of specified fees and single registration period for 15 specified special or personalized license plates after specified date; requiring related rulemaking by 16 Oklahoma Tax Commission; construing provision with respect to apportionment; deleting obsolete language; 17 providing for motor license agent fee when single fee is remitted for registration and special or 18 personalized license plate; modifying reference; updating statutory references; and providing an 19 effective date. 20 21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA: 22 23 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1116, is 24 amended to read as follows:

1 Section 1116. A. Twelve registration periods shall be 2 established for vehicles required to be registered on a staggered 3 basis. The registration periods shall start on the first day of each calendar month and shall end on the last day of that month. 4 5 Unless otherwise provided, all such vehicles where the date of execution of transfer of ownership occurs in this state at any time 6 during a calendar month shall be subject to registration and payment 7 of the fee for the registration period commencing the first day of 8 9 the month of such date of execution of transfer.

10 B. A person who registers more than one vehicle may have all of 11 such vehicles initially registered at the same time or at separate 12 times. Any person who obtains a vehicle may, upon registration, have the registration period adjusted to allow future registration 13 of all such vehicles at the same period or at a different period. 14 15 C. On and after January 1, 2022, if a special or personalized 16 license plate is issued pursuant to this title for a vehicle which is subject to the requirements of Section 1132 of this title, the 17 registration periods for the vehicle may be combined into a single 18 registration period. The Oklahoma Tax Commission shall determine, 19 by rule, a method for adjusting the twelve-month period. 20

21 SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1132, as 22 amended by Section 2, Chapter 337, O.S.L. 2012 (47 O.S. Supp. 2020, 23 Section 1132), is amended to read as follows:

Section 1132. A. For all vehicles, unless otherwise
 specifically provided by the Oklahoma Vehicle License and
 Registration Act, a registration fee shall be assessed at the time
 of initial registration by the owner and annually thereafter, for
 the use of the avenues of public access within this state in the
 following amounts:

7 1. For the first through the fourth year of registration in
8 this state or any other state, Eighty-five Dollars (\$85.00);

9 2. For the fifth through the eighth year of registration in
10 this state or any other state, Seventy-five Dollars (\$75.00);

For the ninth through the twelfth year of registration in
 this state or any other state, Fifty-five Dollars (\$55.00);

4. For the thirteenth through the sixteenth year of

same time and subject to a single registration period. The Oklahoma
Tax Commission shall determine, by rule, a method for making
required fee adjustments when a special or personalized license
plate is obtained during a twelve-month period for which a
registration fee has already been remitted pursuant to this
subsection. The combination of fees in a single remittance shall
not alter the apportionment otherwise provided for by law.

For all-terrain vehicles and motorcycles used exclusively 8 в. 9 for use off roads or highways purchased on or after July 1, 2005, 10 and for all-terrain vehicles and motorcycles used exclusively for use off roads or highways purchased prior to July 1, 2005, which the 11 owner chooses to register pursuant to the provisions of Section 12 1115.3 of this title, an initial and nonrecurring registration fee 13 of Eleven Dollars (\$11.00) shall be assessed at the time of initial 14 registration by the owner. Nine Dollars (\$9.00) of the registration 15 fee shall be deposited in the Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement 16 Fund. Two Dollars (\$2.00) of the registration fee shall be retained 17 by the motor license agent. The fees required by subsection A of 18 this section shall not be required for all-terrain vehicles or 19 motorcycles used exclusively off roads and highways. 20

C. For utility vehicles used exclusively for use off roads or highways purchased on or after July 1, 2008, and for utility vehicles used exclusively for use off roads or highways purchased prior to July 1, 2008, which the owner chooses to register pursuant

1 to the provisions of Section 1115.3 of this title, an initial and nonrecurring registration fee of Eleven Dollars (\$11.00) shall be 2 assessed at the time of initial registration by the owner. Nine 3 Dollars (\$9.00) of the registration fee shall be deposited in the 4 5 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund. Two Dollars (\$2.00) of the registration fee shall be retained by the motor license agent. 6 The fees required by subsection A of this section shall not be 7 required for utility vehicles used exclusively off roads and 8 9 highways.

D. There shall be a credit allowed with respect to the fee for registration of a new vehicle which is a replacement for:

A new original vehicle which is stolen from the
 purchaser/registrant within ninety (90) days of the date of purchase
 of the original vehicle as certified by a police report or other
 documentation as required by the Oklahoma Tax Commission; or

16 2. A defective new original vehicle returned by the 17 purchaser/registrant to the seller within six (6) months of the date 18 of purchase of the defective new original vehicle as certified by 19 the manufacturer.

The credit shall be in the amount of the fee for registration which was paid for the new original vehicle and shall be applied to the registration fee for the replacement vehicle. In no event will the credit be refunded.

1 E. Upon every transfer or change of ownership of a vehicle, the 2 new owner shall obtain title for and, except in the case of salvage 3 vehicles and manufactured homes, register the vehicle within thirty (30) days of change of ownership and pay a transfer fee of Fifteen 4 5 Dollars (\$15.00) in addition to any other fees provided for in this act the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act. No new decal 6 shall be issued to the registrant. Thereafter, the owner shall 7 register the vehicle annually on the anniversary date of its initial 8 9 registration in this state and shall pay the fees provided in subsection A of this section and receive a decal evidencing such 10 11 payment. Provided, used motor vehicle dealers shall be exempt from 12 the provisions of this section.

F. In the event a new or used vehicle is not registered, titled 13 and tagged within thirty (30) days from the date of transfer of 14 15 ownership, the penalty for the failure of the owner of the vehicle to register the vehicle within thirty (30) days shall be One Dollar 16 (\$1.00) per day, provided that in no event shall the penalty exceed 17 One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00). No penalty shall be waived by the 18 Oklahoma Tax Commission or any motor license agent except as 19 provided in subsection C of Section 1127 of this title. Of each 20 dollar penalty collected pursuant to this subsection: 21

Twenty-one cents (\$0.21) shall be apportioned as provided in

5 SECTION 3. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1135.1, as 6 amended by Section 1, Chapter 26, O.S.L. 2016 (47 O.S. Supp. 2020, 7 Section 1135.1), is amended to read as follows:

8 Section 1135.1. A. The Oklahoma Tax Commission is hereby
9 authorized to design and issue appropriate official special license
10 plates to persons as provided by this section.

11 Special license plates shall not be transferred to any other 12 person but shall be removed from the vehicle upon transfer of 13 ownership and retained. The special license plate may then be used 14 on another vehicle but only after such other vehicle has been 15 registered for the current year.

Except as provided in subsection B of this section, special 16 license plates shall be renewed each year by the Tax Commission or a 17 motor license agent. The Tax Commission shall annually notify by 18 mail all persons issued special license plates. The notice shall 19 contain all necessary information and shall contain instructions for 20 the renewal procedure upon presentation to a motor license agent or 21 the Tax Commission. The license plates shall be issued on a 22 staggered system. The motor license agent fees shall be paid out of 23 the Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund. 24

4 2. Tax-Exempt or Nonprofit License Plates - such plates shall
5 be designed for:

- any motor bus, manufactured home, or mobile chapel and 6 a. 7 power unit owned and operated by a religious corporation or society of this state holding a valid 8 9 exemption from taxation issued pursuant to Section 10 501(a) of the Internal Revenue Code, 26 U.S.C., Section 501(a), and listed as an exempt organization 11 in Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, as 12 13 amended, 26 U.S.C., Section 501(c)(3), and that is used by the corporation or society solely for the 14 furtherance of its religious functions, 15
- b. any vehicle owned and operated only by nonprofit
 organizations devoted exclusively to youth programs
 including, but not limited to, the Girl Scouts and Boy
 Scouts of America,
- c. any vehicle, except passenger automobiles, owned or
 operated by nonprofit organizations actually involved
 in programs for the employment of the handicapped and

Such license plates shall be permanent in 17 nature and designed in such a manner as to remain with 18 the vehicle for the duration of the life span of the 19 vehicle or until the title to such vehicle is 20 transferred to an owner who is not subject to this 21 exemption. Such vehicles shall be exempt from the 22 23 registration fees levied under Section 1132 of this title, except that an initial registration fee of 24

Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) shall apply to each vehicle.

3 Any person claiming to be eligible for a tax-exempt or nonprofit license plate under the provisions of this paragraph must have the 4 5 name of the tax-exempt or nonprofit organization prominently displayed upon the outside of the vehicle, except those vehicles 6 registered pursuant to the provisions of subparagraph b of this 7 paragraph, unless such display is prohibited by federal or state law 8 9 or by state agency rules. No vehicle shall be licensed as a tax-10 exempt or nonprofit vehicle unless the vehicle has affixed on each 11 side thereof, in letters not less than two (2) inches high and two 12 (2) inches wide, the name of the tax-exempt or nonprofit 13 organization or the insignia or other symbol of such organization which shall be of sufficient size, shape and color as to be readily 14 legible during daylight hours from a distance of fifty (50) feet 15 while the vehicle is not in motion. 16

3. Physically Disabled License Plates - such plates shall be
 designed for persons who are eligible for a physically disabled
 placard under the provisions of Section 15-112 of this title. It
 shall prominently display the international accessibility symbol,

1 which is a stylized human figure in a wheelchair. The Tax Commission shall also design physically disabled license plates for 2 3 motorcycles owned by persons who are eliqible for a physically disabled placard pursuant to the provisions of Section 15-112 of 4 5 this title. Upon the death of the physically disabled person, the disabled license plate shall be returned to the Tax Commission. 6 There shall be no fee for such plate in addition to the rate 7 provided by the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act for 8 9 the registration of the vehicle. For an additional fee of Ten 10 Dollars (\$10.00), a person eligible for a physically disabled 11 license plate shall have the option of purchasing a duplicate 12 physically disabled special license plate which shall be securely attached to the front of the vehicle. The original physically 13 disabled special license plate shall be securely attached to the 14 rear of the vehicle at all times. 15

Any person who is eligible for a physically disabled license plate and whose vehicle has had modifications because of the physical disability of the owner or of a family member within the second degree of consanguinity of the owner, may register the vehicle for a flat fee of Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00). This fee shall be in lieu of all other registration fees provided by the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act;

4. Indian Tribal License Plates - such plates shall be designed
for any vehicle of a native American Indian Tribal Association

1 exempted in Sections 201 through 204 of Public Law 97-473 and used 2 by the tribal association exclusively for the furtherance of its 3 tribal functions.

The registration fee shall be Eight Dollars (\$8.00) and shall be in addition to all other registration fees provided by law, except the registration fees levied by Section 1132 of this title;

7 5. Hearing Impaired License Plates - such plates shall be designed for persons who are hearing impaired. Such persons may 8 9 apply for a hearing-impaired license plate for each vehicle with a 10 rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less upon the presentment 11 of an application on a form furnished by the Tax Commission and 12 certified by a physician holding a valid license to practice 13 pursuant to the licensing provisions of Title 59 of the Oklahoma Statutes, attesting that the person is hearing impaired. 14 The 15 license plate shall be designed so that such persons may be readily identified as being hearing impaired. There shall be no additional 16 17 fee for the plate, but all other registration fees provided by the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act shall apply; 18

Antique or Classic Vehicles License Plates - such plates
 shall be designed and issued for any vehicle twenty-five (25) years
 of age or older, based upon the date of manufacture thereof and
 which travels on the highways of this state primarily incidental to
 historical or exhibition purposes only.

1 The registration fee shall be Eight Dollars (\$8.00) and shall be in addition to all other registration fees provided by law, except 2 3 the registration fees levied by Section 1132 of this title. Any person registering an antique or classic vehicle may elect to have 4 5 the vehicle registered for a ten-year period. The registration fee for the elected ten-year registration shall be Seventy-five Dollars 6 7 (\$75.00). The motor license agent registering the antique or classic vehicle for a ten-year period shall receive one hundred 8 9 percent (100%) of the fees the motor license agent would have 10 otherwise received pursuant to subsection A of Section 1141.1 of this title if the antique or classic vehicle had been registered on 11 12 an annual basis; and

7. Honorary Consul License Plates - such plates shall be 13 designed to include the words "Honorary Consul" and issued to 14 persons who are honorary consuls authorized by the United States to 15 perform consular duties. Persons applying for such license plates 16 must show proof of standing as an honorary consul. The fee for such 17 plate shall be Eight Dollars (\$8.00) and shall be in addition to all 18 other registration fees required by the Oklahoma Vehicle License and 19 Registration Act. The owner of the vehicle that possesses such 20 license plates shall return the special license plates to the 21 Oklahoma Tax Commission if the owner disposes of the vehicle during 22 the registration year or ceases to be authorized to perform consular 23 duties. 24

C. Special license plates provided by this section shall be
 designed in such a manner as to identify the use or ownership of the
 vehicle. Use of any vehicle possessing a special license plate
 provided by this section for any purpose not specified herein shall
 be grounds for revocation of the special license plate and

8 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund.

Section 1135.2. A. The Oklahoma Tax Commission is hereby authorized to design and issue appropriate official special license plates to persons in recognition of their service or awards as provided by this section.

16 Special license plates shall not be transferred to any other 17 person but shall be removed from the vehicle upon transfer of 18 ownership and retained. The special license plate may then be used 19 on another vehicle but only after such other vehicle has been 20 registered for the current year.

21 Special license plates shall be renewed each year by the Tax 22 Commission or a motor license agent. The Tax Commission shall 23 annually notify by mail all persons issued special license plates. 24 The notice shall contain all necessary information and shall contain

1 instructions for the renewal procedure upon presentation to a motor 2 license agent or the Tax Commission. The license plates shall be 3 issued on a staggered system except for legislative plates and 4 amateur radio operator license plates.

5 On and after January 1, 2022, if a special license plate is issued pursuant to this section, any registration fee required for 6 7 such plate pursuant to this section and the fee required pursuant to Section 1132 of this title shall be remitted at the same time and 8 9 subject to a single registration period. The Oklahoma Tax 10 Commission shall determine, by rule, a method for making required 11 fee and registration period adjustments if a special license plate 12 is obtained during a twelve-month period for which a registration fee has already been remitted pursuant to Section 1132 of this 13 title. The combination of fees in a single remittance shall not 14

15 alter the apportionment otherwise provided for in this section.

The Tax Commission is hereby directed to develop and implement a 16 system whereby motor license agents are permitted to accept 17 applications for special license plates authorized under this 18 section. The motor license agent shall confirm the applicant's 19 eligibility, if applicable, collect and deposit any amount 20 specifically authorized by law, accept and process the necessary 21 information directly into such system and generate a receipt 22 accordingly. For performance of these duties, motor license agents 23 shall retain the fee provided in Section 1141.1 of this title for 24

registration of a motor vehicle. The motor license agent fees for
 acceptance of applications and renewals shall be paid out of the
 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund.

B. The special license plates provided by this section are asfollows:

1. Prisoner of War License Plates - such plates shall be 6 7 designed for honorably discharged or present members of the United States Armed Forces and civilians who were former prisoners of war 8 9 held by a foreign country and who can provide proper certification 10 of that status. Such persons may apply for a prisoner of war 11 license plate for no more than two vehicles with each vehicle having 12 a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. The surviving spouse of any deceased former prisoner of war, if the spouse has not 13 since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is terminated by 14 15 death, divorce, or annulment, may apply for a prisoner of war license plate for one vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one 16 17 (1) ton or less. The fee provided by this section for the special license plate authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to 18 all other registration fees provided by law, except the registration 19 fees levied by Section 1132 of this title; 20

2. National Guard License Plates - such plates shall be
 designed for active or retired members of the Oklahoma National
 Guard. Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide

1 proof of eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be 2 required to provide proof of eligibility annually;

3 Air National Guard License Plates - such plates shall be
4 designed for active or retired members of the Oklahoma Air National
5 Guard. Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide
6 proof of eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be
7 required to provide proof of eligibility annually;

4. United States Armed Forces - such plates shall be designed 8 9 for active, retired, former or reserve members of the United States 10 Armed Forces, and shall identify which branch of service, and carry 11 the emblem and name of either the Army, Navy, Air Force, Marines or 12 Coast Guard, according to the branch of service to which the member belongs or did belong. Former members who have been dishonorably 13 discharged shall not be eligible for such plates. Persons applying 14 15 for such license plate must show proof of present or past military service by presenting a valid Uniformed Services Identity Card or 16 17 the United States Department of Defense Form (DD)214. Retired or former members who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof 18 of eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be required 19 to provide proof of eligibility annually; 20

5. Congressional Medal of Honor Recipient License Plates - such
plates shall be designed for any resident of this state who has been
awarded the Congressional Medal of Honor. Such persons may apply
for a Congressional Medal of Honor recipient license plate for each

vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.
 There shall be no registration fee for the issuance of this plate;

6. Missing In Action License Plates - such plates shall be 3 designed to honor members of the United States Armed Forces who are 4 5 missing in action. The spouse of such missing person, if the spouse has not since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is 6 7 terminated by death, divorce, or annulment, and each parent of the missing person may apply for a missing in action license plate upon 8 9 presenting proper certification that the person is missing in action 10 and that the person making the application is the qualifying spouse 11 or the parent of the missing person. The qualifying spouse and each 12 parent of the missing person may each apply for the missing in action license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity 13 of one (1) ton or less; 14

7. D. The fee for special license plates that provide financial assistance shall be determined in accordance with Section 1 of this act 1135.9 of this title. Provided, the fee shall be no less than Thirty-five Dollars (\$35.00) and shall be in addition to all other registration fees provided by the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act. Thirty-five Dollars (\$35.00) per year of renewal of the fee shall be apportioned as follows:

1. Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) of the fee shall be apportioned to
the License Plate Special Program Assistance Revolving Fund created

1 in Section 1135.8 of this title to be used in the manner detailed in 2 the application for the special license plate;

2. Eight Dollars (\$8.00) of the fee shall be deposited in the
4 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund to be used for the
5 administration of the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act;
6 and

7 3. Any remaining amounts of the fee shall be apportioned as8 provided in Section 1104 of this title.

9 Ε. If a person applies for a special license plate that provides financial assistance, the application shall designate a 10 11 state agency to be responsible for expending the funds generated by 12 the special license plate and the application shall designate a specific public purpose for which the funds are to be used. The 13 application shall include an acknowledgment from the designated 14 15 state agency of their agreement with acceptance of the designated funds. 16

F. Special license plates shall not be transferred to any other person but shall be removed from the vehicle upon transfer of ownership and retained. The special license plate may then be used on another vehicle but only after such other vehicle has been registered for the current year.

22 Special license plates shall be renewed each year by the Tax 23 Commission or a motor license agent, unless authorized by the Tax 24 Commission to be renewed for a period greater than one (1) year.

The Tax Commission shall notify all persons issued special license plates of the renewal procedures prior to the expiration of the special license plate. The notice shall contain all necessary information and shall contain instructions for the renewal procedure upon presentation to a motor license agent or the Tax Commission. The license plates shall be issued on a staggered system.

7 On and after January 1, 2022, if a special license plate is issued pursuant to this section, any registration fee required for 8 9 such plate and the fee required pursuant to Section 1132 of this 10 title shall be remitted at the same time and subject to a single 11 registration period. The Oklahoma Tax Commission shall determine, 12 by rule, a method for making required fee and registration period adjustments if a special license plate is obtained during a twelve-13 month period for which registration has already been remitted 14 pursuant to Section 1132 of this title. The combination of fees in 15 a single remittance shall not alter the apportionment otherwise 16 17 provided for in this section.

18 The Tax Commission is hereby directed to develop and implement a 19 system whereby motor license agents are permitted to accept 20 applications for special license plates authorized under this 21 section. The motor license agent shall confirm the applicant's 22 eligibility, if applicable, collect and deposit any amount 23 specifically authorized by law, accept and process the necessary 24 information directly into such system and generate a receipt

1 accordingly. For performance of these duties, motor license agents 2 shall retain the fee provided in Section 1141.1 of this title for 3 registration of a motor vehicle. The motor license agent fees for 4 acceptance of applications and renewals shall be paid out of the 5 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund.

G. All special plates issued by the Tax Commission prior to the
effective date of this act November 1, 2005, shall not be subject to
the requirements and qualifications outlined in this section.

9 H. As used in this section, "person" includes an individual,
10 group, organization or not-for-profit corporation that is recognized
11 as such by the Internal Revenue Service.

The balance of the funds collected shall be remitted to the Oklahoma Tax Commission as provided in Section 1142 of this title to be apportioned pursuant to Section 1104 of this title.

For each certificate of registration issued for boats and 6 Β. 7 motors, each motor license agent shall be entitled to retain the greater of One Dollar and twenty-five cents (\$1.25) or an amount to 8 9 be determined by the Tax Commission according to the provisions of 10 this subsection. At the end of fiscal year 1997 and each fiscal 11 year thereafter, the Tax Commission shall compute the average amount 12 of registration fees for all boats and motors registered in this 13 state during the fiscal year and shall multiply the result by six and twenty-two one-hundredths percent (6.22%). The resulting 14 15 product shall be the amount which may be retained by each motor license agent for each certificate of registration for boats and 16 17 motors issued during the following calendar year.
