No person shall be allowed to electioneer 14 within three hundred (300) feet of any ballot box the entrance to a 15 16 polling place or in-person absentee voting site or a person who is standing in line to vote outside the polling place or voting site 17 while an election is in progress, nor shall any. No person or 18 persons, except election officials, voters registered and voting at 19 20 the polling place or voting site, a minor child or dependent accompanying such voters and other persons authorized by law, shall 21 be allowed inside the election enclosure or within fifty (50) feet 22 of any ballot box the entrance to a polling place or in-person 23 absentee voting site while an election is in progress. No printed 24

material other than that provided by the election board shall be
publicly placed or exposed within three hundred (300) feet of any

ballot box, the entrance to a polling place or in-person absentee

voting site while an election is in progress.

- B. For purposes of this title:
- 1. "Electioneering" means:

- a. advocating directly for or against a candidate or question that is on the ballot at the election, either verbally or with visual materials, signs or clothing, or
- b. collecting signatures for a petition to place an issue or question on a future ballot; and
- 2. "Election enclosure" means the areas of a polling place where voters sign the precinct registry and are issued ballots, where voting booths are located, where a voting device or ballot box is located, and any room, hallway or other space wherein such activities take place.
- 18 SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 26 O.S. 2011, Section 16-111, is
 19 amended to read as follows:
- Section 16-111. Any person who electioneers within three

 hundred (300) feet of any ballot box the entrance to a polling place

 or in-person absentee voting site or a person who is standing in

 line to vote outside the polling place or voting site while an

 election is in progress, and any person except election officials,
