There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma Department of Commerce from any monies not otherwise appropriated 10 from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal 11 year ending June 30, 2023, the sum of One Hundred Thousand Dollars 12 13 (\$100,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Oklahoma Department of Commerce by law. 14 SECTION 2. Appropriations made by Section 1 of this act, not 15 including appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be 16 budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2023 (hereafter FY-23) 17 or may be budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2024 18 (hereafter FY-24). Funds budgeted for FY-23 may be encumbered only 19 through June 30, 2023 and must be expended by November 15, 2023. 20 Any funds remaining after November 15, 2023, and not budgeted for 21 FY-24, shall lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then 22 current fiscal year. Funds budgeted for FY-24 may be encumbered 23

only through June 30, 2024. Any funds remaining after November 15,

2	current fiscal year. These appropriations may not be budgeted in
3	both fiscal years simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-23, and not
4	required to pay obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted
5	for FY-24, after the agency to which the funds have been
6	appropriated has prepared and submitted a budget work program
7	revision removing these funds from the FY-23 budget work program and
8	after such revision has been approved by the Office of Management
9	and Enterprise Services.
