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6 A Concurrent Resolution relating to adjournment of  
the Legislature for a period in excess of three days;  
7 and providing reciprocal consent of the Oklahoma  
State Senate and the Oklahoma House of  
8 Representatives to adjournment for a period of time  
in excess of three days for the duration of the 2nd  
9 Extraordinary Session of the 58th Oklahoma  
Legislature.

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12 WHEREAS, the Oklahoma Constitution requires the consent of the  
13 two chambers of the Legislature to be adjourned for a period of time  
14 in excess of three (3) days; and

15 WHEREAS, it is foreseeable that either the Oklahoma State Senate  
16 or the Oklahoma House of Representatives or both chambers of the  
17 Legislature may need to adjourn for a period of time of more than  
18 three (3) days between the current point of the 2nd Extraordinary  
19 Session of the 58th Oklahoma Legislature and the sine die  
20 adjournment of such session; and

21 WHEREAS, in the interest of time and to avoid potential  
22 difficulty in obtaining the required assent pursuant to the  
23 provisions of the Oklahoma Constitution it is reasonable for the  
24 Legislature to provide a continuing permission for either chamber or

1 both chambers to be adjourned for a period of time in excess of  
2 three (3) days.

3 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE 2ND  
4 EXTRAORDINARY SESSION OF THE 58TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE HOUSE OF  
5 REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:

6 THAT the Oklahoma State Senate grants its consent to the  
7 Oklahoma House of Representatives to be adjourned for more than  
8 three (3) days from the date of adoption of this measure by the  
9 chambers or the date as of which the measure is acted upon by the  
10 second chamber to consider it, whichever date last occurs.

11 THAT the ongoing mutual consent to adjournment for a period of  
12 time in excess of three (3) days as provided by this measure shall  
13 continue until this measure is either superseded by other action  
14 taken by the Oklahoma Legislature or until the sine die adjournment  
15 of the 2nd Extraordinary Session of the 58th Oklahoma Legislature,  
16 whichever event first occurs.
