15 A Concurrent Resolution encouraging and inviting the
16 exhibitors, breed associations and partners to return
17 to Oklahoma to begin a new tradition of a perpetual
18 Cattlemen's Congress in Oklahoma.

19 WHEREAS, agriculture leaders in Oklahoma organized and held the
20 Inaugural Cattlemen's Congress at the Oklahoma State Fairgrounds in
21 January 2021 in response to the cancellation of the National Western
22 Stock Show in Denver; and

1 WHEREAS, the Cattlemen's Congress was a necessary event for the
2 stabilization of the beef industry and the crossroads of cattle
3 genetics for all of North America; and

4 WHEREAS, more than 2,793 exhibitors from 41 states and three
5 Canadian provinces came to Oklahoma City and exhibited 9,627 head of
6 cattle, breaking records for number of head shown, for most breeds,
7 and for one of the largest cattle shows in all of North America; and

8 WHEREAS, there were 23 sales associated with the Cattlemen's
9 Congress that took place in Oklahoma City grossing more than \$10
10 million in sales, many breaking previous records. There were 1,432
11 lots sold grossing \$10,380,408.00, averaging \$7,254.00 per lot; and

12 WHEREAS, the total economic impact for Oklahoma City for the
13 Cattlemen's Congress surpassed \$40 million.

14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE 1ST SESSION
15 OF THE 58TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES
16 CONCURRING THEREIN:

17 THAT the Oklahoma Legislature encourages and invites the
18 exhibitors, breed associations and partners to return to Oklahoma to
19 begin a new tradition of a perpetual Cattlemen's Congress in
20 Oklahoma.
