10 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE  
11 2ND SESSION OF THE 58TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

12 SECTION 1. The Secretary of State shall refer to the people for  
13 their approval or rejection, as and in the manner provided by law,  
14 the following proposed amendment to Section 1 of Article III of the  
15 Oklahoma Constitution to read as follows:

16 Section 1. Qualifications of electors.

17 Subject to such exceptions as the Legislature may prescribe, ~~all~~  
18 only citizens of the United States, who are over the age of eighteen  
19 (18) years, and who are bona fide residents of this state, are  
20 qualified electors of this state.

21 SECTION 2. The Ballot Title for the proposed Constitutional  
22 amendment as set forth in SECTION 1 of this resolution shall be in  
23 the following form:

2 THE GIST OF THE PROPOSITION IS AS FOLLOWS:

3 This measure amends Section 1 of Article 3 of the Oklahoma  
4 Constitution. It clarifies that only citizens of the United  
5 States are qualified to vote in this state.
