10	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE

12	SECTION 1. The Secretary of State shall refer to the people for
13	their approval or rejection, as and in the manner provided by law,
14	the following proposed amendment to Section 1 of Article III of the
15	Oklahoma Constitution to read as follows:
16	Section 1. Qualifications of electors.
17	Subject to such exceptions as the Legislature may prescribe, $\frac{1}{2}$
18	only citizens of the United States, who are over the age of eighteen
19	(18) years $_{ au}$ and who are bona fide residents of this state $_{ au}$ are
20	qualified electors of this state.
