12 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE
13 2ND SESSION OF THE 58TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

14 SECTION 1. The Secretary of State shall refer to the people for
15 their approval or rejection, as and in the manner provided by law,
16 the following proposed amendment to the Oklahoma Constitution by
17 adding a new Section 6 to Article III to read as follows:

18 Section 6. Each voter shall present proof of identity when
19 voting at any election authorized by law and conducted in accordance
20 with the requirements of the Constitution and laws of this state.
21 Proof of identity shall be required for voting in person, by
22 absentee or mail ballot, and by any other method of voting or
23 casting a ballot authorized by law. The Legislature shall enact

1 laws as may be necessary to specify the requirements for proof of
2 identity for voting as required by this section.

3 SECTION 2. The Ballot Title for the proposed Constitutional
4 amendment as set forth in SECTION 1 of this resolution shall be in
5 the following form:

7 Legislative Referendum No. _____ State Question No. _____

8 THE GIST OF THE PROPOSITION IS AS FOLLOWS:

9 This measure adds Section 6 to Article 3 of the Oklahoma
10 Constitution to require proof of identity to vote in any
11 election authorized by law and conducted in accordance with the
12 requirements of the Constitution and state law. The measure
13 requires proof of identity for all authorized methods of voting.
14 The measure requires the Legislature to enact laws to specify
15 requirements for proof of identity for voting.
