AMENDATORY 15 amended to read as follows: 16 Section 3-107. The State Superintendent of Public Instruction 17 is hereby authorized to administer oaths. Upon proper request, the 18 State Superintendent shall advise school district superintendents 19 and technology center school district superintendents on questions 20 as to the powers, duties and functions of school district officials, 21 and each two (2) years shall cause to be compiled, published and 22 distributed to boards of education and other public officials as 23 deemed necessary the school laws in force. The school laws shall 24 include court decisions, Attorney General's opinions and other

1	informative matter relating to the school laws as deemed
2	appropriate. The State Superintendent shall have control of and
3	direct the State Department of Education and shall perform any other
4	duties pertaining to the public school system as shall be prescribed
5	by law or the State Board of Education. The State Superintendent
