13	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 57 O.S. 2011, Section 400, as
14	amended by Section 2, Chapter 41, O.S.L. 2019 (57 O.S. Supp. 2020,
15	Section 400), is amended to read as follows:
16	Section 400. A. The Department of Corrections is hereby
17	authorized to establish units at one or more institutions for the
18	care and treatment of inmates who are or become in need of acute
19	psychiatric care. The Department shall have the following powers
20	and duties in the operation thereof:
21	1. The Department shall establish procedures to outline means
22	of identification of inmates who are or become in need of acute
23	psychiatric care and for assignment of such inmates to the units
24	described in this subsection. Prior to assignment there shall be a

due process hearing conducted by the Department of Corrections to determine whether the inmate is in need of acute psychiatric care. The inmate shall be entitled to have a staff representative appointed to represent him or her the inmate, if he or she so requests, but shall not have an attorney appointed or paid by the Department to represent him or her the inmate at the administrative hearing; and

8 2. Once an inmate has been assigned to a unit described in this 9 subsection, treatment and medication may be administered to the 10 inmate as provided in Section 5-204 of Title 43A of the Oklahoma 11 Statutes.

12 B. The Carl Albert Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services 13 Center shall provide to the Department of Corrections a psychiatrist 14 as needed to assist in a unit described in subsection A of this

15 section.

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SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2021.
