NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified 14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3311.19 of Title 70, unless 15 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: 16 The Council on Law Enforcement Education and Training may 17 offer training that instructs a peace officer how to alert a school 18 district or charter school when a student enrolled at the school 19 district or charter school has been identified at the scene of a 20 traumatic event or an event that involved a response from an 21 emergency 9-1-1 service. The peace officer may only release the 22 name and birth date of the student directly to the school district

or charter school and state that the student was present at the
