A new section of law to be codified NEW LAW 17 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 335 of Title 61, unless there is 18 created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: 19 The Office of Management and Enterprise Services shall 20 display the national motto of the United States in a prominently 21 visible location in all state buildings. The placement and size of 22 the display shall be in keeping with the placement and size of the 23 display of the national motto in the United States Capitol Visitor

Center in a manner proportional to the state building where the

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1	display is placed. The Office of Management and Enterprise Services
2	shall be directly responsible for the provisions of this act,
3	including any related expenses.
4	B. In the event that the legality or constitutionality of the
5	display is challenged in a court of law, the Oklahoma Attorney
6	General is hereby authorized to prepare and present a legal defense
7	of the display.
8	C. The display of the national motto shall not be construed to
9	mean that the State of Oklahoma favors any particular religion or
10	denomination thereof over others.
11	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2021.
