9	parking in a disabled parking place; excluding certain penalties for a person with a Purple Heart
10	recipient license plate; modifying penalty for certain offense; and providing an effective date.

14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
15	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 15-113, is
16	amended to read as follows:
17	Section 15-113. A. Any person who knowingly makes or procures
18	the making of a false statement in an application submitted pursuant
19	to Sections 15-111 through 15-113 of this title is guilty of a
20	misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be punished by a fine of Five
21	Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) for each falsified statement. This
22	penalty shall be stated on all applications.
23	B. 1. Any person who has not been issued a physically disabled
24	parking placard pursuant to the provisions of Section 15-112 of this

title, a physically disabled license plate issued pursuant to the provisions of Section 1135.1 of this title, a disabled veterans license plate pursuant to the provisions of Section 1135.2 of this title, a Purple Heart recipient license plate issued pursuant to the provisions of Section 1135.2 of this title, a disability sticker issued by the Department of Veterans Affairs and federal military bases, or a physically disabled placard or license plate issued by another state, and uses a placard, sticker, or license plate to park in a disabled parking place is guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be punished by a fine of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00). A person transporting a physically disabled person with an authorized placard, sticker or license plate, as provided in subsection A of Section 11-1007 of this title, shall be excluded from the provisions of this section.

2. Any person who has been issued a physically disabled parking placard pursuant to the provisions of Section 15-112 of this title, a physically disabled license plate issued pursuant to the provisions of Section 1135.1 of this title, er a disabled veterans license plate pursuant to the provisions of Section 1135.2 of this title or a Purple Heart recipient license plate issued pursuant to the provisions of Section 1135.2 of this title, and knowingly allows the placard or license plate to be used by a person not issued the placard or license plate as described in paragraph 1 of this

1	subsection, is guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be
2	punished by a fine of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00).
3	C. A person who knowingly makes a counterfeit physically
4	disabled parking placard or physically disabled license plate is
5	guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be punished by a
6	fine of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) for each counterfeit placard
7	or license plate made by such person.
8	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2021.
