8 An Act relating to the Oklahoma Conservation
9 Commission; requiring that portions of certain funds
10 be used for certain purposes; providing procedures;
11 providing lapse dates; and requiring and prohibiting
12 certain budget procedures.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. From the funds appropriated to the Oklahoma
15 Conservation Commission in Enrolled House Bill No. 2900 of the 1st
16 Session of the 58th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of Ninety Thousand
17 Dollars (\$90,000.00) shall, under the direction of the Executive
18 Director of Conservation, be allocated to the Master Irrigator
19 Program affiliated with the Oklahoma State University Agricultural
20 Extension Service. Such funds shall be used for training within the
21 Master Irrigators Program.

22 SECTION 2. From the funds appropriated to the Oklahoma
23 Conservation Commission in Enrolled House Bill No. 2900 of the 1st
24 Session of the 58th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of Fifty Thousand

1 Dollars (\$50,000.00) shall, under the direction of the Executive
2 Director of Conservation, be allocated to the Master Irrigator
3 Program affiliated with the Oklahoma State University Agricultural
4 Extension Service. Such funds shall be used for studying the
5 Ogallala Aquifer.

6 SECTION 3. Appropriations made by Enrolled House Bill No. 2900
7 of the 1st Session of the 58th Oklahoma Legislature, not including
8 appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for
9 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2022 (hereafter FY-22) or may be
10 budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2023 (hereafter FY-23).
11 Funds budgeted for FY-22 may be encumbered only through June 30,
12 2022, and must be expended by November 15, 2022. Any funds
13 remaining after November 15, 2022, and not budgeted for FY-23, shall
14 lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal
15 year. Funds budgeted for FY-23 may be encumbered only through June
16 30, 2023. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2023, shall lapse
17 to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year.
18 These appropriations may not be budgeted in both fiscal years
19 simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-22, and not required to pay
20 obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-23, after
21 the agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared
22 and submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds
23 from the FY-22 budget work program and after such revision has been
24 approved by the Office of Management and Enterprise Services.
