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8 An Act relating to the State Department of Health;
9 requiring the utilization of certain funds for
10 certain purposes; providing for noncodification;
11 repealing Section 5, Chapter 533, O.S.L. 2021, which
12 relates to position staffing for the Oklahoma Medical
Marijuana Authority; and declaring an emergency.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
15 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

16 From the funds available for budgeting and expenditure during
17 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2022, the State Department of Health
18 shall utilize an amount necessary to successfully regulate and
19 enforce all programs and provisions associated with the Oklahoma
20 Medical Marijuana Authority. Such efforts shall include but not be
21 limited to the hiring and employment of additional staff at the
22 Oklahoma Medical Marijuana Authority, as well as, participating in
23 interagency agreements with state law enforcement agencies for
24 enhanced enforcement.

SECTION 2. REPEALER Section 5, Chapter 533, O.S.L. 2021,
is hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
