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8 An Act relating to the Department of Public Safety;
9 requiring that certain funds be utilized for certain
10 purposes; providing budgeting and expenditure
11 limitations and procedures; providing for lapse of
funds under certain conditions; requiring and
prohibiting certain budget procedures; and providing
for noncodification.

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14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
16 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

17 From the funds appropriated to the Department of Public Safety
18 in Enrolled Senate Bill No. 1040 of the 2nd Session of the 58th
19 Oklahoma Legislature, the Department of Public Safety is hereby
20 authorized to expend Fourteen Million Two Hundred Thirty-one
21 Thousand Dollars (\$14,231,000.00) to provide a pay increase to
22 commissioned law enforcement officers of the Oklahoma Highway
23 Patrol.
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1 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
2 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

3 From the funds appropriated to the Department of Public Safety
4 in Enrolled Senate Bill No. 1040 of the 2nd Session of the 58th
5 Oklahoma Legislature, the Department of Public Safety is hereby
6 authorized to expend Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000.00) to
7 provide a pay increase to persons serving as Communications
8 Dispatchers for the Department of Public Safety.

9 SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
10 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

11 From the funds appropriated to the Department of Public Safety
12 in Enrolled Senate Bill No. 1040 of the 2nd Session of the 58th
13 Oklahoma Legislature, the Department of Public Safety is hereby
14 authorized to expend One Hundred Sixty-four Thousand Dollars
15 (\$164,000.00) to provide a pay increase to persons providing
16 security services at the Oklahoma Capitol building.

17 SECTION 4. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
18 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

19 From the funds appropriated to the Department of Public Safety
20 in Enrolled Senate Bill No. 1040 of the 2nd Session of the 58th
21 Oklahoma Legislature, the Department of Public Safety is hereby
22 authorized to expend One Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars
23 (\$150,000.00) to create and maintain the Mental Wellness Division as
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1 described in Enrolled Senate Bill No. 1613 of the 2nd Session of the
2 58th Oklahoma Legislature.

3 SECTION 5. Appropriations made by this act, not including
4 appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for
5 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2023 (hereafter FY-23) or may be
6 budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2024 (hereafter FY-24).
7 Funds budgeted for FY-23 may be encumbered only through June 30,
8 2023, and must be expended by November 15, 2023. Any funds
9 remaining after November 15, 2023, and not budgeted for FY-24, shall
10 lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal
11 year. Funds budgeted for FY-24 may be encumbered only through June
12 30, 2024. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2024, shall lapse
13 to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year.
14 These appropriations may not be budgeted in both fiscal years
15 simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-23, and not required to pay
16 obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-24, after
17 the agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared
18 and submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds
19 from the FY-23 budget work program and after such revision has been
20 approved by the Office of Management and Enterprise Services.
