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8 An Act relating to the Department of Public Safety;
9 amending 47 O.S. 2021, Section 2-146, which relates
10 to the Department of Public Safety Patrol Academy
11 Revolving Fund; requiring reporting of Oklahoma
12 Highway Patrol Trooper Academies to the Oklahoma
13 Legislature; requiring reporting of expenditures from
14 the Department of Public Safety Patrol Academy
15 Revolving Fund; requiring reporting of monies
16 accruing to the credit of the Department of Public
17 Safety Patrol Academy Revolving Fund; requiring
18 reporting of certain information relating to Oklahoma
19 Highway Patrol Trooper Academies; and providing an
20 effective date.

21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

22 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2021, Section 2-146, is
23 amended to read as follows:

24 Section 2-146. A. There is hereby created in the State
Treasury a revolving fund for the Department of Public Safety, to be
designated the "Department of Public Safety Patrol Academy Revolving
Fund". The fund shall be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal
year limitations. All monies accruing to the credit of said fund
are hereby appropriated and shall be budgeted and expended by the

1 Department of Public Safety for the exclusive purpose of Oklahoma
2 Highway Patrol Trooper Academies. Expenditures from said fund shall
3 be made upon warrants issued by the State Treasurer against claims
4 filed as prescribed by law with the Director of the Office of
5 Management and Enterprise Services for approval and payment.

6 B. On or before December 1 of each year, the Department of
7 Public Safety shall provide a written report on all Oklahoma Highway
8 Patrol Trooper Academies conducted in the then current and preceding
9 state fiscal year to the Speaker of the Oklahoma House of
10 Representatives, the President Pro Tempore of the Oklahoma State
11 Senate, the Chair of the Appropriations and Budget Committee of the
12 Oklahoma House of Representatives, and the Chair of the
13 Appropriations Committee of the Oklahoma State Senate. Such report
14 shall include, but not be limited to, the following information for
15 the then current and preceding state fiscal year:

16 1. A description of all expenditures from the Department of
17 Public Safety Patrol Academy Revolving Fund;

18 2. A description of the source of all monies accruing to the
19 credit of the Department of Public Safety Patrol Academy Revolving
20 Fund;

21 3. A description of all expenditures, including the source of
22 funds for said expenditures, used to conduct each academy;

23 4. The total number of applicants for each academy;

24 5. The total number of persons admitted for each academy;

1 6. The total number of persons graduating from each academy;

2 7. The total number of persons graduating from each academy
3 that do not accept a position within the Oklahoma Highway Patrol;

4 8. The total number of persons graduating from each academy
5 that, upon accepting a position within the Oklahoma Highway Patrol,
6 do not complete service of an initial probationary period as
7 determined by the Department of Public Safety;

8 9. The net number of troopers added to the Oklahoma Highway
9 Patrol in a calendar year;

10 10. A description of any academies planned to be conducted in
11 the upcoming state fiscal year; and

12 11. A description of any planned academy or academies to be
13 conducted within the remaining fiscal year that includes, but is not
14 limited to, the estimated cost of the academy and the proposed
15 source or sources of funding.

16 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
