8 An Act relating to the Office of the Attorney
9 General; requiring that certain funds be utilized for
10 certain purposes; providing budgeting and expenditure
11 limitations and procedures; providing lapse dates;
12 requiring and prohibiting certain budget procedures;
13 and providing for noncodification.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
16 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

17 From the funds appropriated to the Office of the Attorney
18 General in Enrolled Senate Bill No. 1040 of the 2nd Session of the
19 58th Oklahoma Legislature, the Office of the Attorney General is
20 hereby authorized to expend Eight Hundred Seventy Thousand Four
21 Hundred Ninety-nine Dollars (\$870,499.00) to provide a pay increase
22 to persons serving as commissioned law enforcement officers in the
23 Office of the Attorney General.

1 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
2 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

3 From the funds appropriated to the Office of the Attorney
4 General in Enrolled Senate Bill No. 1040 of the 2nd Session of the
5 58th Oklahoma Legislature, the Office of the Attorney General shall
6 utilize Three Million Dollars (\$3,000,000.00) to enhance the
7 operations of the Victim Services Unit.

8 SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
9 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

10 From the funds appropriated to the Office of the Attorney
11 General in Enrolled Senate Bill No. 1040 of the 2nd Session of the
12 58th Oklahoma Legislature, the Office of the Attorney General shall
13 utilize Four Hundred Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$420,000.00) to
14 implement the provisions of Enrolled House Bill No. 4210 of the 2nd
15 Session of the 58th Oklahoma Legislature.

16 SECTION 4. Appropriations made by this act, not including
17 appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for
18 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2023 (hereafter FY-23) or may be
19 budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2024 (hereafter FY-24).
20 Funds budgeted for FY-23 may be encumbered only through June 30,
21 2023, and must be expended by November 15, 2023. Any funds
22 remaining after November 15, 2023, and not budgeted for FY-24, shall
23 lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal
24 year. Funds budgeted for FY-24 may be encumbered only through June

30, 2024. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2024, shall lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year. These appropriations may not be budgeted in both fiscal years simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-23, and not required to pay obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-24, after the agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared and submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds from the FY-23 budget work program and after such revision has been approved by the Office of Management and Enterprise Services.
