11 of the Day of Tears; encouraging Oklahomans to mourn
12 lives lost to abortion in Oklahoma; directing flags
to be flown at half-staff; and providing for
distribution.

15 WHEREAS, to recognize January 22, 2022, as the Day of Tears in
16 Oklahoma and to encourage Oklahoma citizens to lower their flags to
17 half-staff to mourn the innocent, preborn children who have lost
18 their lives due to abortion; and

19 WHEREAS, on January 22, 1973, the majority of the members of the
20 United States Supreme Court erroneously ruled that abortion was a
21 right secured by the Constitution of the United States of America;
22 and

23 WHEREAS, since that ill-fated day, over sixty-one million
24 (61,000,000) preborn children in the United States have perished.
