The Secretary of State shall refer to the people for 16 their approval or rejection, as and in the manner provided by law, 17 the following proposed amendment to Section 1 of Article III of the 18 Oklahoma Constitution to read as follows: 19 Section 1. Subject to such exceptions as the Legislature may 20 prescribe, all only citizens of the United States, over the age of 21 eighteen (18) years, who are bona fide residents of this state, are 22 qualified electors of this state, who upon providing valid 23 identification issued by the United States, the State of Oklahoma, 24 or the government of a federally recognized Indian tribe or nation,

1	may cast a single vote, by secret ballot, which shall solely be used
2	to determine the results of any election required by state or
3	federal law.
4	SECTION 2. The Ballot Title for the proposed Constitutional
5	amendment as set forth in SECTION 1 of this resolution shall be in
6	the following form:

9	THE GIST OF THE PROPOSITION IS AS FOLLOWS:
10	This measure amends Section 1 of Article 3 of the Oklahoma
11	Constitution. It clarifies that only citizens of the United
12	States with a valid identification are qualified to vote in this
13	state.
14	SHALL THE PROPOSAL BE APPROVED?

17	SECTION 3. The Chief Clerk of the House of Representatives,
18	immediately after the passage of this resolution, shall prepare and
