WHEREAS, the dedicated men and women who work as law enforcement officers face extraordinary peril while protecting our citizenry; and

WHEREAS, the State of Oklahoma recognizes not only our law enforcement officers, but also the families of those who work to continue to protect and serve our communities; and

WHEREAS, the Tulsa Police Officers' Memorial is dedicated to those officers who bravely gave their lives in the line of duty and to acknowledge the risk and commitment assumed daily by those law enforcement officers who have served and continue to serve the Tulsa community; and

WHEREAS, since 1917, the Tulsa Police Department has suffered the loss of forty-one (41) law enforcement officers who were killed in the line of duty; and

WHEREAS, the State of Oklahoma appreciates our law enforcement officers who remain resolute, honorable, skilled, and uncompromised in the performance of their duties.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 58TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

THAT the Oklahoma House of Representatives does hereby designate May 7, 2022, as Tulsa Police Officers' Memorial Day.
