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14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:							
15	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be							
16	codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:							
17	This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Facilitating							
18	Internet Broadband Rural Expansion (FIBRE) Act".							
19	SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified							
20	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 158.65 of Title 17, unless there							
21	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:							
22	Any rural electric cooperative that provides or operates							
23	telecommunications or Internet services shall:

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1. Ensure that any rates and fees charged by such rural electric cooperative for attachments to utility poles by communications services providers shall be nondiscriminatory regardless of the services provided by the communications services providers and shall not exceed the annual recurring rate permitted under rules and regulations adopted pursuant to 47 U.S.C., Section 224(d) by the Federal Communications Commission, as such existed on January 1, 2022, and any regulations and Federal Communications Commission decisions promulgated thereunder;

- 2. Establish nondiscriminatory, competitively neutral, and commercially reasonable terms and conditions for attachments to utility poles by any provider of telecommunications or Internet services, which terms and conditions shall comply with the federal pole attachment requirements provided in 47 U.S.C., Section 224, as such existed on January 1, 2022, and any regulations and Federal Communications Commission decisions promulgated thereunder; and
- 3. Not require compliance by a provider of telecommunications or Internet services with utility pole attachment specifications that exceed the specifications in the National Electrical Safety Code, applicable fire safety codes, and any building code or similar code of general applicability for the protection of the public health, safety, or welfare that was adopted by the applicable local government jurisdiction prior to the filing of a utility pole attachment application.
