FLOOR SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to memorial highways and bridges; designating the Senator Roger Ballenger Memorial Highway; designating the Judge Dean Linder Memorial Highway; designating the Loyd Stout Highway; designating the SGT Ronald Crews Bridge; designating the Vernus W. Bales Memorial Highway; designating the MAJ Kerry "WarDog 6" Trent and SSG Michael D. Ward Memorial Trail; designating the SGT Billy Rodgers Memorial Bridge; designating the Harold Haltom Memorial Highway; amending 69 O.S. 2021, Section 1698.310, which relates to the Private Robert "Bob" Clark Memorial Bridge; designating the Jerry Evans Memorial Bridge; designating the WWII Veteran Roy J. "Junior" Herring Memorial Highway; designating the Womack Four Corners; designating the Edgar L. Hamm Memorial Highway; designating the Edward A. Hilliary, Jr. "Junior" Memorial Highway; designating the Okla. Horse Racing Hall of Fame Inductee Carl and Rozella Pevehouse Highway; amending 69 O.S. 2021, Section 1692, which relates to the Medicine Park Trail; modifying location description; amending 69 O.S. 2021, Section 1698.334, which relates to the CSM Junior H. Honeycutt Memorial Highway; modifying location description; amending 69 O.S. 2021, Section 1698.351, which relates to the Martin Dyer Memorial Highway; modifying name of the highway; amending 69 O.S. 2021, Section 1698.354, which relates to the Lonnie D. Cook Memorial Highway; modifying name of

1 the highway; providing for codification; and
2 providing an effective date.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

5 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
6 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.364 of Title 69, unless
7 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

8 The section of State Highway 56 beginning at the intersection of
9 Dripping Springs Road extending easterly to the intersection of
10 Madison Avenue on the west side of the city of Okmulgee in Okmulgee
11 County shall be designated as the "Senator Roger Ballenger Memorial
12 Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable
13 permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the highway.

14 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.365 of Title 69, unless
16 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 The section of U.S. Highway 281 beginning at the intersection of
18 N2400 Road extending approximately five (5) miles east then north to
19 the intersection of E270 Road, south of Alva in Woods County shall
20 be designated as the "Judge Dean Linder Memorial Highway". The
21 Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers
22 bearing that name to be placed on the highway.

1 SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
2 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.366 of Title 69, unless
3 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

4 The section of U.S. Highway 64 beginning at the northern
5 municipal limits of Cherokee extending north to the intersection of
6 State Highway 11 in Alfalfa County shall be designated as the "Loyd
7 Stout Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause
8 suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the
9 highway.

10 SECTION 4. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
11 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.367 of Title 69, unless
12 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

13 The bridge crossing over the Turner Turnpike located on State
14 Highway 18 at the north edge of Chandler in Lincoln County shall be
15 designated as the "SGT Ronald Crews Bridge". The Department of
16 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that
17 name to be placed on the bridge.

18 SECTION 5. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
19 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.368 of Title 69, unless
20 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

21 The section of U.S. Highway 59 in Stilwell beginning on the
22 north side of the State Highway 100 intersection extending north to
23 the intersection of State Highway 51 East in Adair County shall be
24 designated as the "Vernus W. Bales Memorial Highway". The

1 Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers
2 bearing that name to be placed on the highway.

3 SECTION 6. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
4 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.369 of Title 69, unless
5 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

6 The sections of U.S. Highways 60 Business and 60 extending
7 between the Tonkawa and Ponca City National Guard armories in Kay
8 County shall be designated as the "MAJ Kerry "WarDog 6" Trent and
9 SSG Michael D. Ward Memorial Trail". The Department of
10 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that
11 name to be placed on the highways.

12 SECTION 7. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
13 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.370 of Title 69, unless
14 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

15 The bridge crossing over Coal Creek on U.S. Highway 59 north of
16 Panama in LeFlore County shall be designated as the "SGT Billy
17 Rodgers Memorial Bridge". The Department of Transportation shall
18 cause suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on
19 the bridge.

20 SECTION 8. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
21 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.371 of Title 69, unless
22 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

23 The section of State Highway 71 beginning at the intersection of
24 State Highway 9 in Haskell County extending north six (6) miles to

1 the intersection of S4306 Road in McIntosh County shall be
2 designated as the "Harold Haltom Memorial Highway". The Department
3 of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing
4 that name to be placed on the highway.

5 SECTION 9. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
6 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.372 of Title 69, unless
7 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

8 The bridge on U.S. Highway 177 crossing over the Salt Fork
9 Arkansas River south of Ponca City at the Kay County-Noble County
10 line shall be designated as the "Jerry Evans Memorial Bridge". The
11 Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers
12 bearing that name to be placed on the bridge.

13 SECTION 10. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.373 of Title 69, unless
15 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 The section of State Highway 18 beginning at the intersection of
17 State Highway 33 in Cushing extending north two miles in Payne
18 County shall be designated as the "WWII Veteran Roy J. "Junior"
19 Herring Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation shall
20 cause suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on
21 the highway.

22 SECTION 11. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
23 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.374 of Title 69, unless
24 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

1 The intersection of U.S. Highway 177 and State Highway 105 in
2 Lincoln County shall be designated as the "Womack Four Corners".
3 The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent
4 markers bearing that name to be placed on the highways.

5 SECTION 12. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
6 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.375 of Title 69, unless
7 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

8 The section of State Highway 5 beginning at the intersection of
9 State Highway 54 extending east to the intersection of State Highway
10 36 in Tillman County shall be designated as the "Edgar L. Hamm
11 Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause
12 suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the
13 highway.

14 SECTION 13. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.376 of Title 69, unless
16 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 The section of State Highway 49 beginning at the Interstate 44
18 interchange extending west to the intersection of State Highway 58
19 near Medicine Park in Comanche County shall be designated as the
20 "Edward A. Hilliary, Jr. "Junior" Memorial Highway". The Department
21 of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing
22 that name to be placed on the highway.

1 SECTION 14. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
2 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.377 of Title 69, unless
3 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

4 The section of State Highway 76 beginning at the intersection of
5 Getty Road extending north and east along State Highway 7 to the
6 intersection of Delta Road in Carter County shall be designated as
7 the "Okla. Horse Racing Hall of Fame Inductee Carl and Rozella
8 Pevehouse Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause
9 suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the
10 highway.

11 SECTION 15. AMENDATORY 69 O.S. 2021, Section 1692, is
12 amended to read as follows:

13 Section 1692. The portion of State Highway 49 between
14 Interstate 44 and beginning at the intersection of State Highway 58
15 extending west to the Wichita Mountains Wildlife Refuge shall be
16 designated as the "Medicine Park Trail". The Department of
17 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers to be placed
18 upon the portion of highway bearing that designation.

19 SECTION 16. AMENDATORY 69 O.S. 2021, Section 1698.310,
20 is amended to read as follows:

21 Section 1698.310 The bridge over the Cimarron River on U.S.
22 Highway ~~45~~ 287 approximately thirteen (13) miles north of Boise City
23 shall be designated as the "Private Robert "Bob" Clark Memorial
24

1 Bridge". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable
2 permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the bridge.

3 SECTION 17. AMENDATORY 69 O.S. 2021, Section 1698.334,
4 is amended to read as follows:

5 Section 1698.334 Notwithstanding any other provision of law,
6 the section of State Highway 28A in Rogers County beginning at the
7 intersection of State Highway 66 near the Town of Foyil, extending
8 east to the intersection of State Highway 28, then continuing east
9 to the Interstate 44 in Rogers County interchange in Mayes County
10 shall be designated as the "CSM Junior H. Honeycutt Memorial
11 Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable
12 permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the highway.

13 SECTION 18. AMENDATORY 69 O.S. 2021, Section 1698.351,
14 is amended to read as follows:

15 Section 1698.351 Notwithstanding any other provision of law,
16 the section of U.S. Highway 77 beginning at the intersection of
17 Broadway Avenue in Ardmore extending north to the intersection of
18 State Highway 142 in Carter County shall be designated as the "Mayor
19 Martin Dyer Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation
20 shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that name to ~~the~~ be
21 placed on the highway.

22 SECTION 19. AMENDATORY 69 O.S. 2021, Section 1698.354,
23 is amended to read as follows:

1 Section 1698.354 The section of U.S. Highway 62 beginning at
2 the intersection of N3990 Road extending east through the town of
3 Morris to the intersection of N 4030 Road in Okmulgee County shall
4 be designated as the "USS Arizona Survivor Lonnie D. Cook Memorial
5 Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable
6 permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the highway.

7 SECTION 20. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
