FLOOR SUBSTITUTE
An Act relating to higher education; amending 70 O.S. 2021, Section 628.13, which relates to concurrent
enrollment in high school and college or university courses; modifying eligibility; creating a tuition
waiver for freshman and sophomore high school students; and providing an effective date.
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BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 70 O.S. 2021, Section 628.13, is
amended to read as follows:
Section 628.13 A. 1. The Oklahoma State Regents for Higher
Education, in cooperation with the State Board of Education, shall
actively encourage allow the concurrent enrollment in college or
university courses of eligible high school students in grades nine
through twelve who have been approved for concurrent enrollment by
their parent or legal guardian and school counselor, or their parent
or legal guardian for students receiving high-school-level
instruction at home, on high school campuses, on college and
university campuses and via online courses.

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2. The State Regents and State Board shall establish concurrent
 enrollment requirements with an emphasis on determining course
 readiness and take all necessary actions to ensure the availability
 of concurrent enrollment opportunities to students <u>in grades nine</u>
 <u>through twelve</u> in all Oklahoma high schools.

B. The State Board of Education in cooperation with the
Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education shall prepare
promotional materials explaining the requirements, features and
opportunities of concurrent enrollment and shall ensure that the
independent school districts distribute the materials to each
student prior to enrollment for each year of high school.

C. No institution of The Oklahoma State System of Higher Education shall deny enrollment in any course to any otherwise eligible high school student, or student of at least thirteen (13) years of age who is receiving high-school-level instruction at home, who meets the requirements of concurrent enrollment, nor shall any independent school district prohibit any student who meets the requirements of concurrent from participating.

D. 1. Each high school senior who meets the eligibility requirements for concurrent enrollment shall be entitled to receive a tuition waiver equivalent to the amount of resident tuition for a maximum of eighteen (18) credit hours in their senior year.

23 2. Subject to the high school senior concurrent enrollment24 program being fully funded, each high school junior who meets the

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eligibility requirements for concurrent enrollment shall be entitled to receive a tuition waiver equivalent to the amount of resident tuition for a maximum of nine (9) credit hours in their junior year, subject to the availability of funds.

5 3. Subject to the high school senior concurrent enrollment program and the high school junior concurrent enrollment program 6 7 being fully funded, each high school freshman and sophomore who meets the eligibility requirements for concurrent enrollment shall 8 9 be entitled to receive a tuition waiver equivalent to the amount of 10 resident tuition for a maximum of six (6) credit hours in their 11 freshman year and a maximum of six (6) credit hours in their 12 sophomore year, subject to the availability of funds.

13 <u>4.</u> Tuition waivers provided pursuant to this section shall be 14 granted without any limitation on the number of waivers granted in 15 any year other than the amount of funds available for the program 16 and the number of eligible applicants.

17 Ε. When a student earns college credit through concurrent 18 enrollment, school districts shall provide academic credit for any 19 concurrently enrolled higher education courses that are correlated 20 with the academic credit awarded by the institution of higher 21 education. Academic credit shall only be transcripted as elective 22 credit if there is no correlation between the concurrent enrollment 23 higher education course and a course provided by the school 24 district.

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F. On or before December 1 of each year, the Oklahoma State
 Regents for Higher Education shall issue an annual report on the
 concurrent enrollment program implemented pursuant to this section.
 The annual report shall include but not be limited to the following
 information:

6 1. The number of students participating in concurrent7 enrollment;

8 2. The number of students participating in concurrent
9 enrollment who received tuition waivers pursuant to subsection D of
10 this section;

11 3. The high school graduation rate of students described in 12 paragraphs 1 and 2 of this subsection; and

4. The number of students described in paragraphs 1 and 2 of
this subsection who earned an associate's degree or a bachelor's
degree at an institution of higher education.

16 The annual report shall be posted on the websites of the 17 Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education and the State Department 18 of Education.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.

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
