12	motorized scooter; requiring operator to observe all applicable traffic safety regulations; authorizing
13	municipalities to regulate the usage of motorized scooters; and providing an effective date.

16	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
17	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2021, Section 1-133.3, is
18	amended to read as follows:
19	Section 1-133.3 Motorized scooter.
20	A. A "motorized scooter" is any vehicle having:
21	1. Not more than three wheels in contact with the ground;
22	2. Handlebars and a foot support or seat for the use of the
23	operator; <u>and</u>
24	

3. A power source that is capable of propelling the vehicle at
 a maximum design speed of not more than twenty-five (25) thirty-five
 (35) miles per hour on level ground, and:

- a. if the power source is a combustion engine, has a
  piston or rotor displacement of thirty-five fifty
  cubic centimeters (35 cu cm) (50 cu cm) or less
  regardless of the number of chambers in the power
  source, or
- 9 b. if the power source is electric, has a power output of
  10 not more than one thousand (1,000) watts is programmed
  11 by the manufacturer not to exceed thirty-five (35)
  12 miles per hour on level ground.

13 <u>Regardless of power source, local governments may set maximum speed</u> 14 requirements by local ordinance.

B. For purposes of this section, an electric personal assistive
mobility device, as defined in Section 1-114A of this title,
bicycle, electric-assisted bicycle, or motorized bicycle, as defined
in Section 1-104 of this title, shall not be considered a motorized
scooter.

20 C. A motorized scooter shall not be required to be registered 21 under the laws of this state.

22 <u>1.</u> The operator of a motorized scooter shall <u>be at least</u>
 23 <u>fourteen (14) years of age unless an older age is required by local</u>
 24 ordinance.

1	2. The operator of a motorized scooter shall not be required to
2	possess a driver license or <u>unless required by local ordinance.</u>
3	3. The operator of a motorized scooter shall not be required to
4	comply with the vehicle insurance or financial responsibility laws
5	of this state unless required by local ordinance, and shall observe
6	all applicable traffic safety regulations when driving on a public
7	roadway as required by statute and local ordinances.
8	D. Municipalities shall have authority to regulate the usage of
9	motorized scooters on all public roadways, trails, sidewalks, and
10	other public spaces, and to determine appropriate locations for use.
11	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
