FLOOR SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to motorized scooters; amending 47 O.S. 2021, Section 1-133.3, which relates to the definition of a motorized scooter; modifying definition; requiring minimum age to operate a motorized scooter; requiring operator to observe all applicable traffic safety regulations; authorizing municipalities to regulate the usage of motorized scooters; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2021, Section 1-133.3, is amended to read as follows:

Section 1-133.3 Motorized scooter.

A. A "motorized scooter" is any vehicle having:

1. Not more than three wheels in contact with the ground;
2. Handlebars and a foot support or seat for the use of the

operator; and

1 3. A power source that is capable of propelling the vehicle at
2 a maximum design speed of not more than ~~twenty-five (25)~~ thirty-five
3 (35) miles per hour on level ground, and:

4 a. if the power source is a combustion engine, has a
5 piston or rotor displacement of ~~thirty-five~~ fifty
6 cubic centimeters ~~(35 cu cm)~~ (50 cu cm) or less
7 regardless of the number of chambers in the power
8 source, or

9 b. if the power source is electric, ~~has a power output of~~
10 ~~not more than one thousand (1,000) watts~~ is programmed
11 by the manufacturer not to exceed thirty-five (35)
12 miles per hour on level ground.

13 Regardless of power source, local governments may set maximum speed
14 requirements by local ordinance.

15 B. For purposes of this section, an electric personal assistive
16 mobility device, as defined in Section 1-114A of this title,
17 bicycle, electric-assisted bicycle, or motorized bicycle, as defined
18 in Section 1-104 of this title, shall not be considered a motorized
19 scooter.

20 C. A motorized scooter shall not be required to be registered
21 under the laws of this state.

22 1. The operator of a motorized scooter shall be at least
23 fourteen (14) years of age unless an older age is required by local
24 ordinance.

1 2. The operator of a motorized scooter shall not be required to
2 possess a driver license ~~or~~ unless required by local ordinance.

3 3. The operator of a motorized scooter shall not be required to
4 comply with the vehicle insurance or financial responsibility laws
5 of this state unless required by local ordinance, and shall observe
6 all applicable traffic safety regulations when driving on a public
7 roadway as required by statute and local ordinances.

8 D. Municipalities shall have authority to regulate the usage of
9 motorized scooters on all public roadways, trails, sidewalks, and
10 other public spaces, and to determine appropriate locations for use.

11 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
