16	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified		
17	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.364 of Title 69, unless		
18	there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:		
19	The bridge located on U.S. Highway 81, approximately one (1)		
20	mile south of the State Highway 19 West intersection, in Grady		
21	County shall be designated as the "SGT Mycal Prince Memorial		
22	Bridge". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable		
23	permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the bridge.		
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1 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.365 of Title 69, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: The bridge over Walnut Creek on State Highway 24, east of the town of Washington in McClain County, shall be designated as the "SSGT Jerry Michael Chitwood Memorial Bridge". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the bridge. SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.366 of Title 69, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: The section of U.S. Highway 266 beginning at the intersection of Porter Road extending northeasterly to the intersection of County Road N4030 in Okmulgee County shall be designated as the "SP-4 Wilbert Gresham Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the highway. A new section of law to be codified SECTION 4.
