[Department of Transportation - feasibility study -
emergency]

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1737 of Title 69, unless there
is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The Oklahoma Turnpike Authority shall conduct a study and
prepare a report concerning the proposed construction of the South
Extension Turnpike, Outer Loop-East-West Connector Turnpike, or any
subsequent naming designations, of any part or parts thereof in
their entirety that pass through any portion of the City of Norman.

1 The study shall include, but not be limited to, the following
2 information:

3 1. The factors that were considered when determining the route
4 of the turnpikes or turnpike extensions described in this section;

5 2. Whether the proposed routes have been determined to be the
6 most effective routes regarding the flow of traffic and a discussion
7 as to the factors considered in making that determination;

8 3. The specific impact and effect that the planned route will
9 have on businesses, citizens, and private and public property where
10 the planned routes will be implemented;

11 4. Whether any alternate routes were considered by the Oklahoma
12 Turnpike Authority and the factors considered as to why the
13 alternate routes were not chosen for the turnpikes or turnpike
14 extensions described in this section; and

15 5. Any other factors relevant to the decision of the location
16 of the turnpikes or turnpike extensions described in this section
17 considered by the Oklahoma Turnpike Authority.

18 The Oklahoma Turnpike Authority shall deliver two copies of the
19 study and a report containing the findings of the study to the
20 Governor, President Pro Tempore of the Senate, and the Speaker of
21 the House of Representatives at least one (1) year prior to issuing
22 bonds for the construction on the turnpikes or turnpike extensions
23 described in this section. Upon receipt of the study and report,
24 the President Pro Tempore of the Senate shall submit one copy of the

1 study and report to the Chairman of the Senate Transportation
2 Committee, or successor committee. The Speaker of the House of
3 Representatives shall submit one copy of the study and report to the
4 Chairman of the House Transportation Committee, or successor
5 committee.

6 Upon the receipt of the study and report the Legislature may
7 modify the authorization for construction or location of the
8 turnpikes or turnpike extensions described in this section, as
9 provided in Section 1732 of Title 69 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

10 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
11 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
12 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
13 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
