10 An Act relating to the state Medicaid program;
11 defining term for specific purpose; providing for
12 codification; providing effective date; and declaring
13 for emergency.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
17 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3241.11 of Title 63, unless
18 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

19 For the purposes of a federal Medicaid supplemental payment
20 program for nonstate government owned nursing facilities and
21 hospitals, "nonstate government owned" means owned by a government
22 other than the state including but not limited to:

23 1. A board of control created by and charged by a board of
24 county commissioners with the management and control of a county

1 hospital as provided by Section 789 of Title 19 of the Oklahoma
2 Statutes;

3 2. A public trust or other organization that is created by a
4 county under Section 176 of Title 60 of the Oklahoma Statutes and is
5 under lease with a board of county commissioners for the operation
6 of a county hospital as provided by Section 789 of Title 19 of the
7 Oklahoma Statutes;

8 3. A municipal governing body that has established and
9 maintains a municipal hospital as provided by Section 30-101 of
10 Title 11 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

11 4. A board of control created by and charged by a municipal
12 governing body with the management and control of a municipal
13 hospital as provided by Section 30-102 of Title 11 of the Oklahoma
14 Statutes; and

15 5. Any municipal or governmental body other than the state
16 authorized to operate a health care facility including a hospital or
17 nursing facility.

18 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2022.

19 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
20 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
21 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
22 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
