Honeycutt Memorial Highway; designating the Ada Lois Sipuel Fisher Memorial Bridge; designating the Joe W. McBride Memorial Bridge; designating the Deputy Jarid Taylor Memorial Highway; designating the USAF Capt. Nick Karpis Vietnam Veteran Memorial Highway; designating the Sgt. Clyde Runyan Memorial Highway; designating the Sgt. Maj. Marvail Lewis Memorial Causeway; designating the County Commissioner Roy Rains Memorial Highway; designating the PFC Richard Tafoya Gurule Memorial Highway; designating the Capt. David Arthur Peters Memorial Highway; designating the Ray Davis Memorial Intersection; designating the Robert L. Horton Memorial Highway; designating the John L. Hayden Memorial Highway; designating the Creede Speake Jr. Memorial Highway; designating the W.D. Bill Amis Memorial Bridge; designating the SSG Michael R. Robson Memorial Highway; designating the Carolyn Woods Memorial Bridge; designating the Martin Dyer Memorial Highway; designating the Sgt. Craig Johnson Memorial Highway; designating the U.S. Senator James Inhofe Interchange; designating the Lonnie D. Cook Memorial Highway; designating the Corporal Kyle Jeffrey Davis Memorial Highway; designating the Wilmot E. Chamberlain Memorial Bridge; requiring certain markers; amending Section 11, Chapter 369, O.S.L. 2019 (69 O.S. Supp. 2020, Section 1698.296), which relates to the Councilwoman Avalon Reese Memorial Highway; modifying name of certain memorial highway; providing for codification; providing for noncodification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

1 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
2 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.308 of Title 69, unless
3 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

4 The section of U.S. Highway 64 beginning at the western
5 municipal limits of the town of Buffalo in Harper County extending
6 to N1860 Road shall be designated as the "William Charles "Charley"
7 Coen Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation shall
8 cause suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on
9 the highway.

10 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
11 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.309 of Title 69, unless
12 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

13 The bridge over Turkey Creek in Woodward County approximately
14 two (2) miles east of the Ellis and Woodward County border on
15 Highway 15 shall be designated as the "Bud Martin Memorial Bridge".
16 The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent
17 markers bearing that name to be placed on the bridge.

18 SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
19 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.310 of Title 69, unless
20 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

21 The bridge over the Cimarron River on Highway 15 approximately
22 thirteen (13) miles north of Boise City shall be designated as the
23 "Private Robert "Bob" Clark Memorial Bridge". The Department of
24

1 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that
2 name to be placed on the bridge.

3 SECTION 4. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
4 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.311 of Title 69, unless
5 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

6 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the section of State
7 Highway 287 beginning at the municipal limits of Boise City
8 extending southeast to the Oklahoma-Texas border in Cimarron County
9 shall be designated as the "President Donald J. Trump Highway". The
10 Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers
11 bearing that name to be placed on the highway.

12 SECTION 5. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
13 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

14 The cost associated with signage related to Section 4 of this
15 act shall be paid by the Senate and House of Representatives authors
16 and coauthors of this act.

17 SECTION 6. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
18 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.312 of Title 69, unless
19 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

20 The section of State Highway 17 beginning at the east municipal
21 limits of Elgin extending to the intersection with NE Miller Street
22 in Comanche County shall be designated as the "Speaker Pro Tempore
23 Jim R. Glover Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation
24

1 shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be
2 placed on the highway.

3 SECTION 7. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
4 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.313 of Title 69, unless
5 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

6 The bridge over Western Avenue on Interstate 240 within the
7 municipal limits of Oklahoma City shall be designated as the "Medal
8 of Honor Recipient Sergeant John R. Crews Memorial Bridge". The
9 Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers
10 bearing that name to be placed on the bridge.

11 SECTION 8. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
12 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.314 of Title 69, unless
13 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

14 The portion of State Highway 271 beginning south of the
15 municipal limits of Hugo and ending north of the municipal limits of
16 Grant shall be designated as the "Trooper J.C. Magar Memorial
17 Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable
18 permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the highway.

19 SECTION 9. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
20 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.315 of Title 69, unless
21 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

22 The bridge over Coal Creek located on US Route 75 Business
23 within the municipal limits of Henryetta shall be designated as the
24 "Congressional Medal of Honor Recipient Edward A. DeVore, Jr.

1 Memorial Bridge". The Department of Transportation shall cause
2 suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the
3 bridge.

4 SECTION 10. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
5 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.316 of Title 69, unless
6 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

7 The portion of State Highway 56 beginning just west of North
8 Wood Drive extending approximately one (1) mile west through the
9 municipal limits of Okmulgee shall be designated as the "Navy Cross
10 Recipient CPL Russell Keck Memorial Highway". The Department of
11 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that
12 name to be placed on the highway.

13 SECTION 11. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.317 of Title 69, unless
15 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 The section of State Highway 20 beginning at the junction of
17 State Highway 20 and N 145th E Avenue in Owasso extending east to
18 the junction of State Highway 20 and S 4080 Road in Rogers County
19 shall be designated as the "TSgt Marshal D. Roberts Memorial
20 Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable
21 permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the highway.

22 SECTION 12. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
23 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.318 of Title 69, unless
24 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

1 The section of State Highway 30 beginning at the southern
2 municipal limits of the town of Sweetwater in Beckham County
3 extending south to the intersection of State Highway 30 and County
4 Road 1140 in Beckham County shall be designated as the "Sweetwater
5 Veterans Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation shall
6 cause suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on
7 the highway.

8 SECTION 13. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
9 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.319 of Title 69, unless
10 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

11 The bridge over Interstate 35 on State Highway 74 within the
12 municipal limits of Purcell in McClain County shall be designated as
13 the "SSGT Cecil Wellman Memorial Bridge". The Department of
14 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that
15 name to be placed on the bridge.

16 SECTION 14. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
17 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.320 of Title 69, unless
18 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

19 The bridge over Little Skin Bayou on U.S. Highway 64 in Sequoyah
20 County shall be designated as the "Officer Michael Bruce Keen
21 Memorial Bridge". The Department of Transportation shall cause
22 suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the
23 bridge.

1 SECTION 15. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
2 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.321 of Title 69, unless
3 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

4 The bridge over Chouteau Creek on U.S. Highway 77 in Cleveland
5 County shall be designated as the "Tommy Wayne Haley Memorial
6 Bridge". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable
7 permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the bridge.

8 SECTION 16. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
9 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.322 of Title 69, unless
10 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

11 The bridge located on Interstate 44 over State Highway 49 within
12 Comanche County shall be designated as the "MSGT Michael Werdehoff
13 Vietnam MIA Memorial Bridge". The Department of Transportation
14 shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be
15 placed on the bridge.

16 SECTION 17. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
17 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.323 of Title 69, unless
18 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

19 The portion of State Highway 30 beginning at the northern
20 municipal limits of the town of Sweetwater extending north to the
21 intersection of State Highway 30 and E 1060 Road in Roger Mills
22 County shall be designated as the "SP4 Alfred Dean Hildebrand
23 Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause
24

1 suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the
2 highway.

3 SECTION 18. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
4 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.324 of Title 69, unless
5 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

6 The bridge located on State Highway 34 over the Salt Fork of the
7 Red River, south of Mangum, in Greer County shall be designated as
8 the "James Amos Callins Memorial Bridge". The Department of
9 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that
10 name to be placed on the bridge.

11 SECTION 19. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
12 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.325 of Title 69, unless
13 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

14 The portion of State Highway 51B beginning one half mile west of
15 the western municipal limits of Porter and ending one half mile east
16 of the eastern municipal limits of Porter shall be designated as the
17 "Lieutenant Eugene Smith Memorial Highway". The Department of
18 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that
19 name to be placed on the highway.

20 SECTION 20. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
21 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.326 of Title 69, unless
22 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

23 The bridge over Elk Creek on State Highway 9 located
24 approximately one (1) mile west of Hobart in Kiowa County shall be

1 designated as the "WWII Doolittle Raider - Bombardier Sgt. Robert
2 James "R.J." Stephens Memorial Bridge". The Department of
3 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that
4 name to be placed on the bridge.

5 SECTION 21. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
6 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.327 of Title 69, unless
7 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

8 The bridge over Flat Creek on State Highway 34 located
9 approximately one-half (0.5) mile north of West Madison Avenue near
10 the town of Carter in Beckham County shall be designated as the
11 "U.S. Army PFC Keith N. Cantrell Memorial Bridge". The Department
12 of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing
13 that name to be placed on the bridge.

14 SECTION 22. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.328 of Title 69, unless
16 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 The section of State Highway 82 beginning at the intersection of
18 U.S. Highway 62 and extending southeasterly to the intersection of
19 East Flournory Road south of Tahlequah in Cherokee County shall be
20 designated as the "Paul Blevins, Jr., and Michael Rogers Memorial
21 Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable
22 permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the highway.
23
24

1 SECTION 23. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
2 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.329 of Title 69, unless
3 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

4 The bridge over Muddy Boggy Creek on State Highway 43 located
5 approximately one (1) mile east of the town of Coalgate in Coal
6 County shall be designated as the "Stiles Brothers Vietnam Veteran
7 Memorial Bridge". The Department of Transportation shall cause
8 suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the
9 bridge.

10 SECTION 24. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
11 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.330 of Title 69, unless
12 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

13 The section of U.S. Highway 69 in Ottawa County beginning at the
14 intersection of Newman Road then extending north to the intersection
15 of Commerce Street in the City of Commerce shall be designated as
16 "South Mickey Mantle Boulevard". The Department of Transportation
17 shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be
18 placed on the highway.

19 SECTION 25. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
20 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.331 of Title 69, unless
21 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

22 The section of State Highway 18 beginning at Deep Rock Road and
23 extending north three (3) miles in Payne County shall be designated
24 as the "Terry L. Hoggatt Memorial Highway". The Department of

1 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that
2 name to be placed on the highway.

3 SECTION 26. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
4 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.332 of Title 69, unless
5 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

6 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the bridge over
7 South 129th Avenue on State Highway 51, also known as the Broken
8 Arrow Expressway, in Broken Arrow, Tulsa County, shall be designated
9 as the "Jennifer McClendon Memorial Bridge". The Department of
10 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that
11 name to be placed on the bridge.

12 SECTION 27. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
13 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.333 of Title 69, unless
14 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

15 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the bridge over Lee
16 Boulevard on Interstate 44 in the City of Lawton in Comanche County
17 shall be designated as the "Maj. Charles E. Stiles Memorial Bridge".
18 The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent
19 markers bearing that name to be placed on the bridge.

20 SECTION 28. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
21 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.334 of Title 69, unless
22 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

23 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the section of State
24 Highway 28A beginning at the intersection of State Highway 66 near

1 the Town of Foyil extending east to the intersection of Interstate
2 44 in Rogers County shall be designated as the "CSM Junior H.
3 Honeycutt Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation shall
4 cause suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on
5 the highway.

6 SECTION 29. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
7 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.335 of Title 69, unless
8 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

9 The bridge crossing over the Washita River on U.S. Highway 62
10 located three-tenths (0.3) of a mile east of the H.E. Bailey
11 Turnpike near Chickasha in Grady County shall be designated as the
12 "Ada Lois Sipuel Fisher Memorial Bridge". The Department of
13 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that
14 name to be placed on the bridge.

15 SECTION 30. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
16 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.336 of Title 69, unless
17 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

18 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the bridge crossing
19 over the Washita River on State Highway 8 north of the city of
20 Anadarko in Caddo County shall be designated as the "Joe W. McBride
21 Memorial Bridge". The Department of Transportation shall cause
22 suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the
23 bridge.

24

1 SECTION 31. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
2 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.337 of Title 69, unless
3 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

4 The section of the U.S. Highway 70 Bypass beginning just south
5 of U.S. 70 and extending south and west to the intersection of
6 McLean Drive on the west side of the city of Durant in Bryan County
7 shall be designated as the "Deputy Jarid Taylor Memorial Highway".
8 The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent
9 markers bearing that name to be placed on the highway.

10 SECTION 32. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
11 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.338 of Title 69, unless
12 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

13 The section of State Highway 78 beginning just north of the
14 intersection of State Highway 22 extending northwesterly to the
15 eastern municipal limits of Milburn in Johnston County shall be
16 designated as the "USAF Capt. Nick Karpis Vietnam Veteran Memorial
17 Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable
18 permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the highway.

19 SECTION 33. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
20 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.339 of Title 69, unless
21 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

22 The section of State Highway 7 beginning at the north municipal
23 limits of Mill Creek in Johnston County then extending northerly to
24 the Murray County line shall be designated as the "Sgt. Clyde Runyan

1 Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause
2 suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the
3 highway.

4 SECTION 34. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
5 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.340 of Title 69, unless
6 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

7 The causeway over Old Spiro Lake on State Highway 9 in LeFlore
8 County shall be designated as the "Sgt. Maj. Marvail Lewis Memorial
9 Causeway". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable
10 permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the causeway.

11 SECTION 35. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
12 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.341 of Title 69, unless
13 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

14 The section of U.S. Highway 64 beginning at the intersection of
15 E1040 Road extending northerly to the intersection of E. 128th
16 Street in Muskogee County shall be designated as the "County
17 Commissioner Roy Rains Memorial Highway". The Department of
18 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that
19 name to be placed on the highway.

20 SECTION 36. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
21 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.342 of Title 69, unless
22 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

23 The section of State Highway 20 beginning at the intersection of
24 U.S. Highway 75 extending east two (2) miles to the intersection of

1 N. Memorial Road in Tulsa County shall be designated as the "PFC
2 Richard Tafoya Gurule Memorial Highway". The Department of
3 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that
4 name to be placed on the highway.

5 SECTION 37. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
6 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.343 of Title 69, unless
7 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

8 The section of State Highway 9 beginning at the intersection of
9 Interstate 35 extending west to the intersection of U.S. Highway 62
10 in McClain County shall be designated as the "Capt. David Arthur
11 Peters Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation shall
12 cause suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on
13 the highway.

14 SECTION 38. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.344 of Title 69, unless
16 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 The intersection of State Highway 66 and Banner Road in Canadian
18 County shall be designated as the "Ray Davis Memorial Intersection".
19 The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent
20 markers bearing that name to be placed at the intersection.

21 SECTION 39. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
22 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.345 of Title 69, unless
23 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

1 The section of State Highway 25 beginning at the intersection of
2 State Highway 2 extending east to the western municipal limits of
3 Bluejacket in Craig County shall be designated as the "Robert L.
4 Horton Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation shall
5 cause suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on
6 the highway.

7 SECTION 40. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
8 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.346 of Title 69, unless
9 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

10 The section of State Highway 3 West beginning at the west side
11 of the State Highway 19 interchange extending west to the
12 intersection of County Road 1510 in Pontotoc County shall be
13 designated as the "John L. Hayden Memorial Highway". The Department
14 of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing
15 that name to be placed on the highway.

16 SECTION 41. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
17 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.347 of Title 69, unless
18 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

19 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the section of State
20 Highway 53 beginning at the intersection of Midway Road extending
21 east through the community of Milo to the intersection of Woodford
22 Road in Carter County shall be designated as the "Creede Speake Jr.
23 Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause
24

1 suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the
2 highway.

3 SECTION 42. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
4 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.348 of Title 69, unless
5 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

6 The bridge over Honey Creek Pass located on Interstate 35 just
7 south of Exit 51 in Murray County shall be designated as the "W.D.
8 Bill Amis Memorial Bridge". The Department of Transportation shall
9 cause suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on
10 the bridge.

11 SECTION 43. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
12 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.349 of Title 69, unless
13 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

14 The section of State Highway 199 from the western municipal
15 limits of Dickson to the eastern municipal limits of Ardmore shall
16 be designated as the "SSG Michael R. Robson Memorial Highway". The
17 Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers
18 bearing that name to be placed on the highway.

19 SECTION 44. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
20 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.350 of Title 69, unless
21 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

22 The bridge crossing over US Highway 69 Business located on US
23 Highway 69 at the south edge of McAlester in Pittsburg County shall
24 be designated as the "Carolyn Woods Memorial Bridge". The

1 Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers
2 bearing that name to be placed on the bridge.

3 SECTION 45. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
4 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.351 of Title 69, unless
5 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

6 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the section of U.S.
7 Highway 77 beginning at the intersection of Broadway Avenue in
8 Ardmore extending north to the intersection of State Highway 142 in
9 Carter County shall be designated as the "Martin Dyer Memorial
10 Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable
11 permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the highway.

12 SECTION 46. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in
13 the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.352 of Title 69, unless there
14 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

15 The section of U.S. Highway 169 beginning at the intersection of
16 East 81st Street South extending north to the south side of State
17 Highway 51 in Tulsa County shall be designated as the "Sgt. Craig
18 Johnson Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation shall
19 cause suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on
20 the highway.

21 SECTION 47. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
22 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.353 of Title 69, unless
23 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the interchange of
2 Interstate 40 and Douglas Boulevard located in Midwest City in
3 Oklahoma County shall be designated as the "U.S. Senator James
4 Inhofe Interchange". The Department of Transportation shall cause
5 suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed at the
6 interchange.

7 SECTION 48. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
8 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.354 of Title 69, unless
9 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

10 The section of U.S. Highway 62 beginning at the intersection of
11 N3990 Road extending east through the town of Morris to the
12 intersection of N4030 Road in Okmulgee County shall be designated as
13 the "Lonnie D. Cook Memorial Highway". The Department of
14 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that
15 name to be placed on the highway.

16 SECTION 49. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
17 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.355 of Title 69, unless
18 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

19 The section of U.S. Highway 75 beginning at the northern
20 municipal limits of Dewey extending north to the southern municipal
21 limits of Copan in Washington County shall be designated as the
22 "Corporal Kyle Jeffrey Davis Memorial Highway". The Department of
23 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that
24 name to be placed on the highway.

SECTION 50. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.356 of Title 69, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The bridge over the Fort Smith Stockyards on U.S. Highway 64 west of the Oklahoma/Arkansas state line in Sequoyah County shall be designated the "Wilmot E. Chamberlain Memorial Bridge". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the bridge.

SECTION 51. AMENDATORY Section 11, Chapter 369, O.S.L. 2019 (69 O.S. Supp. 2020, Section 1698.296), is amended to read as follows:

Section 1698.296 The section of U.S. Highway 64 Business beginning at West 23rd Street South extending north to the intersection of West Southside Blvd. in the City of Muskogee in Muskogee County shall be designated as the "Councilwoman Avalon ~~Reese~~ Reece Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the highway.

SECTION 52. This act shall become effective November 1, 2021.
